Description:

Rock Mountain Mine is a sand and gravel mining operation located on Queens Highway in the Town of Rochester, Ulster County, New York. The regulated process consists of a portable aggregate crushing and screening plant. Sand and gravel will be excavated from the mine and hauled to the 400 ton per hour portable aggregate plant for crushing and screening. The portable aggregate plant consists of a number of conveyors, a jaw crusher, a secondary rock crusher and a screening unit. Power is supplied by a 1011 horsepower diesel fired caterpillar generator set. The primary Standard Industrial Classification Code is 1442 - Construction Sand and Gravel.

The Facility's potential to emit regulated pollutants is below major stationary source thresholds. New Source Performance Standards 40CFR Part 60 Subpart OOO applies to this facility.



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By acceptance of this permit, the permittee agrees that the permit is contingent upon strict compliance with the ECL, all applicable regulations, the General Conditions specified and any Special Conditions included as part of this permit.

Notification of Other State Permittee Obligations

**** General Provisions ****
GENERAL CONDITIONS - Apply to ALL Authorized Permits.

Inspection by the Department

Applicable State Requirement: ECL 19-0305

Item 1.1:

The permitted site or facility, including relevant records, is subject to inspection at reasonable hours and intervals by an authorized representative of the Department of Environmental Conservation (the Department) to determine whether the permittee is complying with this permit and the ECL. Such representative may order the work suspended pursuant to ECL 71-0301 and SAPA 401(3).

Item 1.2:

The permittee shall provide a person to accompany the Department's representative during an inspection to the permit area when requested by the Department.

Item 1.3:

A copy of this permit, including all referenced maps, drawings and special conditions, must be available for inspection by the Department at all times at the project site or facility. Failure to produce a copy of the permit upon request by a Department representative is a violation of this permit.

Condition 2: Relationship of this Permit to Other Department Orders and Determinations
Applicable State Requirement: ECL 3-0301.2(m)

Item 2.1:

Unless expressly provided for by the Department, issuance of this permit does not modify, supersede or rescind any order or determination previously issued by the Department or any of the terms, conditions or requirements contained in such order or determination.

Condition 3: Applications for Permit Renewals and Modifications

Applicable State Requirement: 6NYCRR 621.13(a)

Item 3.1:

The permittee must submit a separate written application to the Department for renewal, modification or transfer of this permit. Such application must include any forms or supplemental information the Department requires. Any renewal, modification or transfer granted by the Department must be in writing.

Item 3.2:

The permittee must submit a renewal application at least 180 days before expiration of permits for Title V Facility Permits, or at least 30 days before expiration of permits for State Facility Permits.

Condition 4: Permit Modifications, Suspensions, and Revocations by the Department
Applicable State Requirement: 6NYCRR 621.14

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Item 4.1:

The Department reserves the right to modify, suspend, or revoke this permit. The grounds for modification, suspension or revocation include:

- a) the scope of the permitted activity is exceeded or a violation of any condition of the permit or provisions of the ECL and pertinent regulations is found;
- b) the permit was obtained by misrepresentation or failure to disclose relevant facts;
- c) new material information is discovered; or
- d) environmental conditions, relevant technology, or applicable law or regulation have materially changed since the permit was issued.
