Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Delist Notice

The Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Program (the State Superfund Program) is the State's program for identifying, investigating, and cleaning up sites where the disposal of hazardous waste may present a threat to public health and/or the environment. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) maintains a list of these sites in the Registry of Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites (the "Registry"). The DEC has determined that this site (see map on reverse side) no longer presents a threat to public health or the environment and is proposing to delist the site from the Registry for the following reason(s):

Threats from the disposal of hazardous waste at this site were addressed by implementation of the remedy identified for the site by a Record of Decision (ROD): A soil removal Interim Remedial Measure (IRM) was conducted during November, 1997. This IRM included the excavation of a total of 25.15 tons of contaminated non-hazardous soil from the area of the two underground leaching pools. The excavation extended three to four feet below the water table. End point soil samples were procured, and analytical results showed no residual soil contamination in this area. The excavations were backfilled with clean fill and closed, and the excavated soil was disposed of in accordance with existing regulations. All construction of the components of the site-wide remedy was completed no later than 1997. The November 1997 Final Remediation Report confirms that the remedy has been constructed consistent with the requirements in the ROD. The ROD required No Further Action with a groundwater monitoring program for a period of three years or until the concentrations of contaminants are less than groundwater standards for two consecutive sampling rounds. A soil vapor intrusion evaluation conducted in November of 2013 found that there were no impacts by site related contaminants to on or off site buildings. Institutional controls were not required to ensure the protectiveness of the site. A significant threat to public health and the environment no longer exists at the site.

Public comments are being received before the decision to remove the site from the Registry is finalized. The public comment period will end October 5, 2014. If we do not receive any new or additional information during this public comment period that changes our delist proposal, we will delist the site on or after October 26, 2014.
