Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Classification Notice

The Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Site Program (the State Superfund Program) is the State's program for identifying, investigating, and cleaning up sites where the disposal of hazardous waste may present a threat to public health and/or the environment. The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) maintains a list of these sites in the Registry of Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites (the "Registry"). The site identified above, and located on a map on the reverse side of this page, was recently added to the Registry as a Class 2 site that presents a significant threat to public health and/or the environment for the following reason(s):

Elevated levels of volatile organic compounds, specifically tetrachloroethene, are present in on-site soil and groundwater. In addition, underground storage tanks remain at the site and petroleum-related compounds exceed applicable groundwater standards. There is a potential for people to be exposed to site-related contamination via direct contact with soil and groundwater and, possibly, from soil vapor intrusion. Further investigation is needed to identify and address the nature and extent of site-related contamination and to evaluate any potential exposure pathways.

DEC will keep you informed throughout the investigation and cleanup of the site.


