What They Eat

Aphids are the most common food of both adults and larva. They also feed on mites, small insects and insect eggs.

Where They Live

In winter, lady bugs cluster together in houses, logs or under rocks. In warmer weather they are found in meadows, gardens, marshes, and farm fields.

Special Features

Many people buy lady bugs and let them go in their gardens. The lady bugs eat aphids that can hurt flowers, vegetables and other crops. Lady bugs are also called lady beetles.
