



Presenting: The Bluebird

Draw a picture of a bird you have seen.

Where it Lives:

Bluebirds nest in holes in trees made by other birds (like woodpeckers) or in boxes made by people.

What it Eats:

Bluebirds eat insects and spiders that they find crawling around in fields.

Special Features:

If bluebirds nest a second time in the same season, young bluebirds sometimes help their parents feed their younger brothers and sisters. Along the east-west US Route 20, there is a trail of bluebird nest boxes erected and checked by volunteers. It stretches across the whole state, nearly 500 miles.
