In the Matter of an Emergency Order for the Establishment of a Quarantine District and Protective Zone to Prevent the Spread of Oak Wilt Disease Pursuant to ECL § 9-1303

Order

WHEREAS:

- Oak wilt is a serious tree disease that was first detected in the Great Lakes Region of the United States in 1944. Since that time, it has spread killing thousands of oak trees each year. Oak wilt is caused by a fungus, Bretziella fagacearum, which causes blockage of the water conducting vessels (xylem) of host trees slowing the movement of water within the tree whereby the leaves wilt and drop off. Infected red oak trees typically die within a few weeks of infection. The disease is spread through underground root systems and by beetles that colonize within infected trees. In addition, the spread of oak wilt disease is associated with the movement of firewood and other wood products. Thus, immediate action by the Department of Environmental Conservation ("Department") is necessary to eliminate this infestation and prevent the spread of this fungus to protect oak trees in the surrounding area and the entire state;
- In August 2008 oak wilt was confirmed for the first time in New York State on twoproperties in the community of Glen Oaks within the town of Glenville, SchenectadyCounty, New York;
- On October 16, 2008, Commissioner Grannis issued an emergency order directing staff to develop an eradication plan with public involvement and to notify affected landowners; that order further established a protective zone and ordered that no person shall remove any oak tree or portion



thereof from such protective zone;

- In October 2008 Department staff consulted with US Forest Service oak wilt experts develop and implement a comprehensive oak wilt response and eradication plan for the infested area. This plan was developed with the involvement of the affected homeowners and community;
- In September 2016, Department and New York State Department of Agriculture andMarkets ("AGM") staff confirmed that oak wilt disease had infected oak trees inthe Town of Canandaigua, Ontario County, New York. Commissioner Seggos issued an order directing staff to develop an eradication plan with public involvement and to notify affected landowners; that order further established a protective zone;
- In August 2018, the Department confirmed that oak wilt disease had infected oaktrees in the Town of South Bristol, Ontario County, New York;
- In August 2022, the Department was conducting surveys for oak wilt and identified symptomatic trees in the Town of Bristol, Ontario County, New York. Samples were collected and confirmed to have oak wilt by the Cornell Plant Disease Diagnostic Clinic;
- The Environmental Conservation Law ("ECL") § 9-1303(5)
 authorizes the Department by order to establish a Quarantine
 District to prohibit the movement of materials which may be
 harboring forest tree diseases;
- ECL § 9-1303(7) empowers the Department to establish protective zones for the purpose of preventing the spread of forest tree diseases:

- Department staff has delineated the area infected with oak wilt disease
 within the Towns of South Bristol and Bristol in Ontario County, New York,
 as described on Schedule A, which shall be known hereinafter as the
 "Quarantine District and Protective Zone"; and
- ECL § 9-1303(7) provides that in establishing protective zones, the
 Department shall have the authority to enter onto private lands to
 make such modification in the composition of forest growth as it may
 deem necessary for the purpose of preventing the spread of forest
 tree diseases, including: spraying, cutting, destroying or otherwise
 treating trees or other vegetation located in the Protective Zone.

NOW, **THEREFORE**, pursuant to ECL § 9-1303 and based upon the above:

- I HEREBY FIND that Oak Wilt Disease has infected oak trees in the Town of Bristol, Ontario County, New York and that, in order to protect the forests of New York State, the Department must take immediate action to eradicate this infestation and prevent its spread;
 - **1A.** Except as authorized by the Department by permit, no person shall move any living, dead, standing, cut or fallen oak trees or any portion thereof, including branches, logs, stumps or roots, green oak lumber and firewood (of any species) outside of the Quarantine District and Protective Zone unless it hasbeen chipped to less than one (1) inch in two (2) dimensions or firewood that has been treated in a kiln certified by AGM reaching a core temperature of seventy one (71) degrees Celsius (one hundred sixty (160) degrees Fahrenheit) for seventy five (75) minutes (refer to CRR-NY 192.5);
 - **1B.** Oak nursery stock grown for a period exceeding two years within the Quarantine District and Protective Zone may be moved out of the Quarantine District and Protective Zone only pursuant to a permit issued by the AGM, Division of Plant Industry, specifically authorizing such movement, and only if the shipping nursery is under a

compliance agreement with the AGM, Division of Plant Industry. This compliance agreement will require oak wilt surveys in nurseries and specify production practices to minimize the risk of spreading oak wilt through nursery stock movement. It will also require nursery growers handling regulated articles to compile, maintain and makeavailable for inspection for a period of two years, records of inventory and sales of regulated articles on a form or forms prescribed by the Commissioner of AGM;

- **1C.** Living or dead oak trees or any portion thereof and firewood (of any species) may be moved outside of the Quarantine District and Protective Zone under a Department, Division of Lands and Forests limited transportation permit, providing the materials are from sources apparently free of oak wilt disease; transportation of such materials shall only occur from August 1st through March 31st; materials shall be shipped with a copy of the permit and proper shipping documents.
- 2. I HEREBY ORDER Department staff to continue to develop and implement, with public involvement, an control plan including: (1) the removal of infected andpotentially infected host trees, (2) proper disposal of infected material, and (3) any other action reasonably necessary to prevent the spread of oak wilt disease.
- 3. I FURTHER ORDER Department staff to continue to take reasonable steps and exercise due diligence to notify, work cooperatively with and enter into agreements with affected landowners as appropriate to implement the Department's control plan;
- 4. I **FURTHER ORDER** that the infected area, as delineated on Schedule A and the attached map of boundaries, is designated as the Quarantine District and Protective Zone for the purposes of carrying out this order;
- 5. I **FURTHER ORDER** that the areas where any oak species is removed by the Department shall remain free of intentionally planted oak of any species by humans, except as authorized by the Department in writing, including any appropriate preventive measures;
- 6. I FURTHER ORDER that the Quarantine District and Protective Zone


- established in this Order supersedes the Protective Zone previously established in Bristol and South Bristol by the Order dated January 7, 2019.
- 7. I **FURTHER ORDER** that a copy of this order be immediately filed in the Office of the Clerk of Ontario County; and
- 8. **THIS ORDER SHALL BE EFFECTIVE** ten days from the filling thereof with suchOffice and shall remain effective until oak wilt disease has been declared controlled from within the Quarantine District and Protective Zone.

General Description of Bristol South Bristol Protective Zone and Quarantine District (PZQD)

Starting at the Canandaigua, Bristol, and South Bristol town boundary intersection, the PZQD goes east until it intersects Route 21 and turns south along Route 21. Approximately 0.3 miles north of the Route 21 and Eagles Nest Drive intersection, the PZQD turns southwest traveling along tax parcel boundaries until reaching Stid Hill Road. From Stid Hill Road, the boundary moves along a tax parcel boundary until reaching the west side of New York State DEC property where it continues north along the western boundary of the state property for approximately 1.3 miles. At that property corner, the PZQD cuts west to Route 64 and goes north along Route 64 to the Bristol South Bristol border. Once at the town border, the PZQD continues west crossing South Hill Road and continuing to the rear of the properties touching South Hill Road. At the rear property corner, the PZQD goes north for approx. 1 mile, following tax parcel boundaries. The PZQD then goes east along tax parcel boundaries crossing South Hill Road reaching Stid Hill MUA on Route 64. The PZQD boundary continues through Stid Hill MUA until reaching Dugway Rd. The PZQD follows Dugway Rd. southeast then cuts away from the road to meet the town intersection of Canandaigua, Bristol, and South Bristol. The PZQD never cuts through a tax parcel, it will include all or none of a parcel. Included parcels are listed in the table below.
