Asian longhorned beetles and emerald ash borers can destroy forests. They move to new areas via firewood. Help stop their spread by using locally cut or heat-treated firewood.

New York State Firewood Regulations:

- It is illegal to bring untreated firewood into New York State
- It is illegal to transport firewood more than 50 miles from its source unless it has been heat-treated
- When transporting untreated firewood within 50 miles of its source, you must carry proof of source, such as a receipt
- Insect quarantines that further restrict the transport of firewood exist in some counties of New York State. Research your area or camping destination to find out more
