## DON'T MOVE FIREWOOD!

If you move firewood, you may also be giving a free ride to dangerous hitchhikers that threaten New York's trees and forests like the Asian Longhorn Beetle.

To help safeguard New York's forests from the growing threat posed by firewood infested with invasive insects and/or diseases, a regulation is now in effect that:

- Bans importing firewood into New York unless it has been treated (kiln-dried) to eliminate pests
- Prohibits the movement of untreated firewood within New York more than 50 miles from its source

To protect New York's trees, please:

- Leave firewood at home—do not transport it to campgrounds or parks
- Only buy firewood that has been harvested locally or treated for pests
- Burn all firewood brought to the campsite
