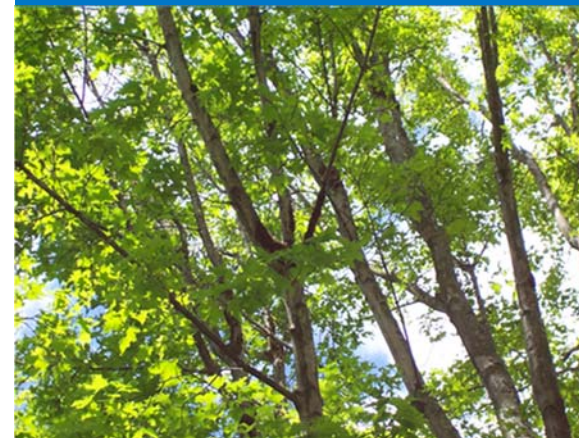
New York Urban Forestry Council

Session One

Agents of decline - An introduction to the sources of forest decline and their diagnosis in New York's forests. Includes a discussion of abiotic agents, insects, decay pathogens, and exotics and how to diagnose decline symptoms.

Session Two

Spotted Lanternfly and Oak Wilt – Identification, biology, life cycle, and the impacts of spotted lanternfly (SLF) and an update on the status of oak wilt in NY, including the latest management techniques used by DEC.

Session Three

DEC Pesticide Regulatory Update – A review of the pesticide applicator certification process and levels of certification, business/agency registration, personal protective equipment, daily record keeping and annual reports, and proposed changes to the DEC pesticide regulations.
