
We have reviewed the traffic information from the original submission received, as well as separate submissions from GTS Consulting, and have concluded that the traffic impacts associated with the proposed action do not represent a substantial increase to the existing traffic volumes, nor do they present a need for mitigation to the highway.

Because the development requires access to the State Highway system, a Highway Work Permit (HWP) will be required. Under the Department's HWP process, a detailed review of the point of access to the state highway will be conducted and appropriate geometric elements will need to be constructed.

As a permitting agency, the New York State Department of Transportation shall be considered an Involved Agency under the SEQRA.

We appreciate your keeping us apprised of this matter.
