Here is the answer to your other question:

Crestwood Midstream Partners LP (NYSE: CMLP) merged with and into Inergy Midstream, L.P. (NYSE: NRGM) on October 7, 2013. Contemporaneously with the closing of the merger, Inergy Midstream, L.P. changed its name to Crestwood Midstream Partners and changed its NYSE listing symbol to "CMLP." Finger Lakes LPG Storage, LLC, US Salt, LLC and Arlington Gas Storage, LLC remain wholly-owned subsidiaries of Crestwood Midstream Partners LP (formerly Inergy Midstream, L.P.). The properties to be used for the Finger Lakes LPG storage project continue to be owned by Fingers Lakes LPG Storage, LLC and/or US Salt, LLC, and Crestwood Midstream Partners LP has no intention of changing the identity of the permit applicant.

Kevin,

After our conversation earlier this week concerning Crestwood, I thought it would be good if I set out my understanding of salient points for your review and confirmation or correction. Can you please confirm or correct my understanding, which follows? Of course, add any other information you think helpful. My more broad intent is to confirm that DEC remains aware of the party(ies) legally responsible for and sponsoring the proposed Finger Lakes LPG project.

There has been a merger of Inergy LP with a Crestwood organization. Finger Lakes LPG LLC, U.S. Salt LLC and Arlington Gas Storage LLC all still exist, and remain wholly owned subsidiaries of Inergy Midstream, LLC - which also still exists, and is part of the merged Crestwood/Inergy company. (Note that I'm not sure of the name of that merged company.) None of the properties proposed to be used for the Finger Lakes LPG storage project - which currently are owned by Fingers Lakes LPG Storage LLC and/or U.S. Salt LLC - are expected to change owners.
