**PROPOSED RMU-2 LANDFILL  
RADIO ANNOUNCEMENT**

The New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) invites the public to review and comment on the proposal for CWM Chemical Services, L.L.C., to construct and operate a new landfill and other units to store, treat, and dispose of hazardous and industrial non-hazardous waste at the company's facility located in Model City, NY. The applications, draft environmental impact statement, and draft permits are available for review.

The date to file written comments has been extended by 45 days from September 5, 2014 to October 20, 2014. All persons, organizations, corporations, or government agencies who may be affected by the proposal are invited to submit written comments.
