Waste Tire Stockpile Assessment Summary Sheet - Site 5-01**

Mohawk Tire Towns of Waterford & Halfmoon

Region 5, Saratoga County

**Site Setup: Divided into 2 sections
one section has burned tires and chips
other section piles of tires**



**Number of piles: 19 on main section, whole tires,
3 on lower section, chipped and burned,
mixed with other waste and debris**

**Separation of tire piles: lanes between each one,
approx. 40-50 ft. wide**

**Dimensions of tire piles: 19 piles are relatively
uniform, 54 X 200 X 25**



Number of tires: 8,000,000 estimated

Condition of Tires:

Majority are whole tires

Some are chipped or cut out of sidewalls

Few with rims still in (< 5%)

Few OTR tires

Dirt and concrete mixed in with some piles

Some piles have weeds growing on top

Access to site:

Roadways between piles overgrown

some parts partially washed away by rain

Site is fenced in and locked,

on a sloped hill, not too steep



Distance to population: About a mile
