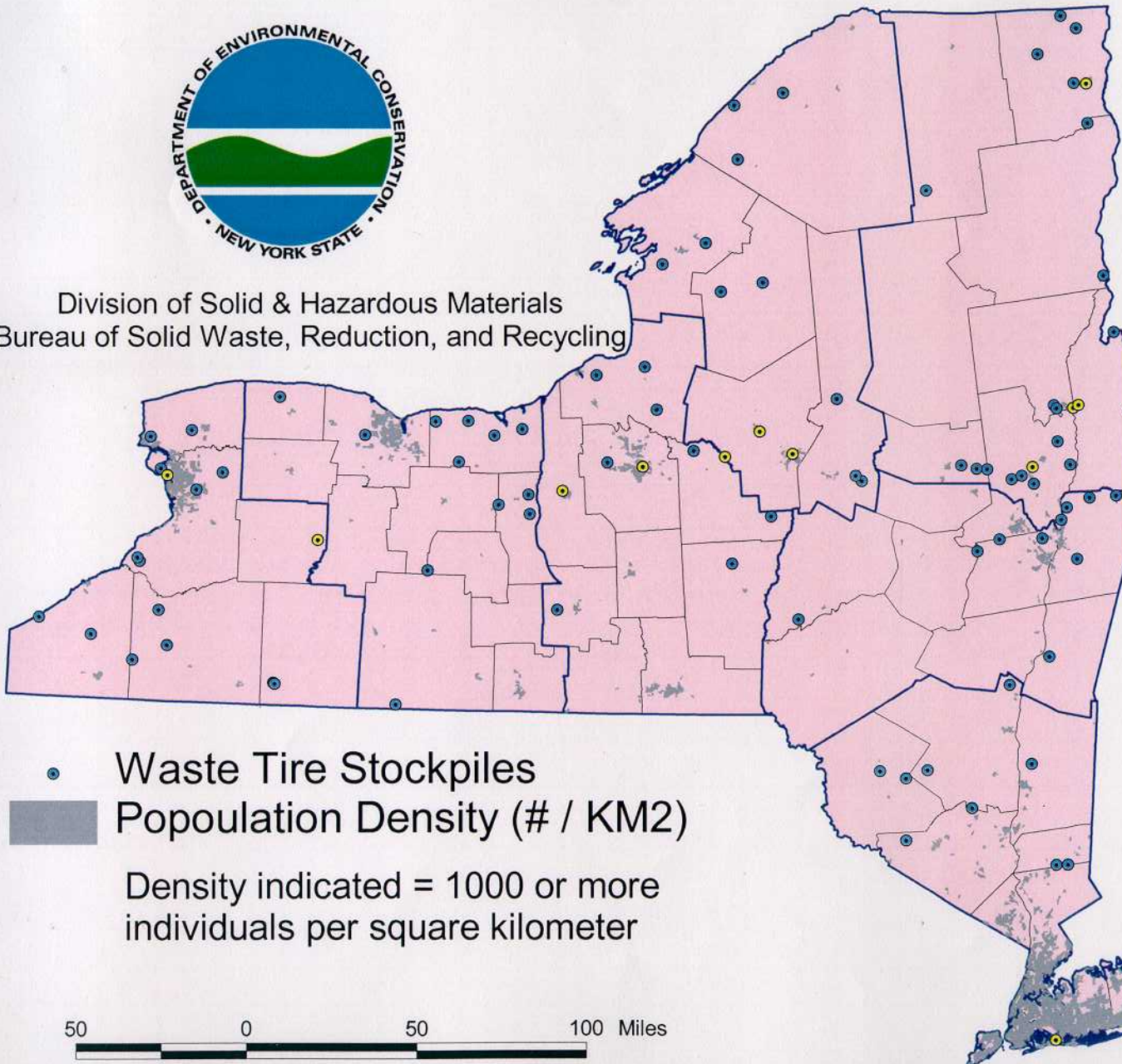
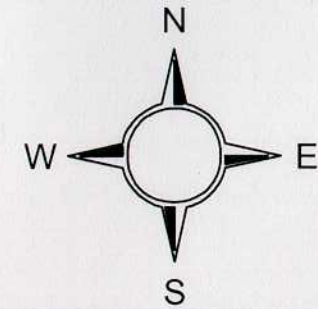


Waste Tire Stockpiles Within 1 km of Population Centers

Population density was determined by 2000 census data averaged over the area of the census tract.

The threshold of 1000 individuals per square kilometer was specified as it is indicative of many types of residential settings including housing configurations in large and small cities, towns, and suburban developments.

A distance of 1 kilometer was used as a buffer as it is considered to be the maximum distance impacts from tire stockpiles would be noticed. In examining census data, there were also tracts of slightly lower population density between higher density tracts. This 1 km allowance help to avoid missing these tracts.
