Good reclamation deserves to be recognized. Read further to find out how to apply for New York State's **Annual Mined Land Reclamation Award**. You may even win a national award.

New York Award Categories

Companies located in New York may compete in either of two categories:

- Mines 10 acres or fewer affected.
- Mines over 10 acres affected.



Project Criteria

The reclamation effort must voluntarily go beyond regulatory requirements, and:

- Produce a community benefit,
- Involve a new technique, or
- Use an innovative solution for a difficult problem.

Applicant Qualifications

Applicants must be in good standing with the Environmental Conservation Law. Project submitted for consideration must be completed or in substantial progress by September 15, 2006.
