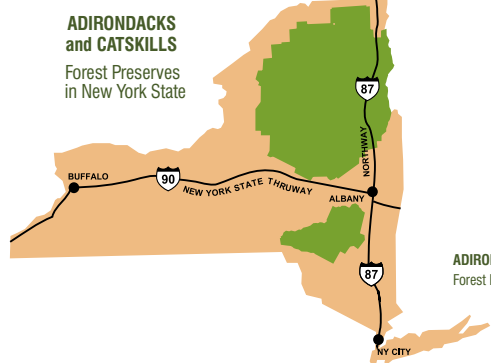
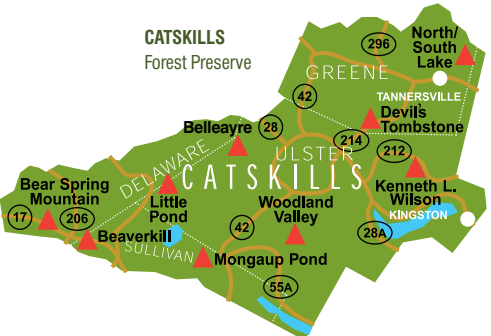

# New York State Department of Environmental Conservation

## Camping Reservation System 2009

Welcome to New York's statewide Camping Reservation System. The Department of Environmental Conservation administers all state campgrounds within the Adirondack and Catskill Forest Preserves. There are no state cabin rentals in the Adirondacks or Catskills. Through the New York State Camping Reservation System, you may reserve space which will guarantee accommodations at any state camping area. While not required, reservations are highly recommended.

### Making a Reservation

**Fee = \$9.00/campsite**  
To make a reservation, please call: **1-800-456-CAMP** (TTY: 1-800-304-1265) between the following hours:

**January 1, 2009 through March 14, 2009**  
Monday – Friday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

**March 15, 2009 through Labor Day, 2009**  
Monday – Friday 8 a.m. – 8 p.m.

**Saturday – Sunday 9 a.m. – 3 p.m.**

**The day after Labor Day, 2009 through March 14, 2010**  
Monday – Friday 9 a.m. – 5 p.m.

**The day after Labor Day, 2009 through November 30, 2009**  
Saturday – Sunday 9 a.m. – 12 p.m.

Reservations will be accepted for camping from 2 days to 9 months in advance of the date of your planned arrival. DEC campgrounds open after Labor Day (September 7, 2009) will accept reservations except for Fish Creek.

### Duration of Stay

Reservations may be made at a Department of Environmental Conservation campsite for a minimum of 1-3 nights to a maximum of 14 nights depending on the campground and the time of year.

### Reservation and Camping Fee Payments

#### 1) Credit Cards: Visa, Mastercard

Payment for reservations is due at the time the reservation is being made. Please have your credit card number ready when making your reservation.

#### 2) Check

if paying by check, your reservation must be phoned in at least 21 days prior to the date of your scheduled arrival. Full payment of your camping and reservation fees must be received within 5 days of making your reservation to avoid automatic cancellation.

#### 3) Money Order

if paying by money order, your reservation must be phoned at least 5 business days prior to the date of your scheduled arrival. Full payment of your camping and reservation fees must be received by the Reservation Center a minimum of 2 days prior to your arrival.

### Reservation Confirmation

When making a reservation you will be assigned a Reservation Number. To assist in the registration process, please have this number with you when you register at the park. **Record Your Reservation Number Here:**

### Cancellations, Refunds & Changes

**Cancellation: Fee = \$9.00/campsite.**

• Cancellations made 8 days or more prior to your scheduled arrival date will result in a refund equal to the amount already paid minus the non-refundable reservation fee and cancellation fee.

• Cancellations made less than 8 days prior to your scheduled arrival date will result in a refund equal to the amount already paid minus the non-refundable reservation fee, the cancellation fee, and your first night's camping fee.

• To cancel a reservation more than 2 days prior to the date of your scheduled arrival, contact Customer Service at 1-800-777-9644 or on-line at [www.ReserveAmerica.com](http://www.ReserveAmerica.com) for internet reservations.

• To cancel a reservation within 2 days of your scheduled arrival, contact the campground directly. (See reverse for campground directory.)

• No refunds will be issued for cancellations made after 9 p.m. on your scheduled date of arrival.

**Reservation Change: Fee = \$9.00.**

To make any changes to your reservation you must call 1-800-456-CAMP 2 days or more prior to your scheduled date of arrival. A reservation change fee will be applied. Changes cannot be made less than 2 days prior to your scheduled date or arrival. Within 2 days of your scheduled arrival you must cancel your reservation with the campground. Cancellation and reservation fees will be applied.

### At the Campground

**Arriving without a reservation:** If you do not wish to utilize the reservation system, our campgrounds will still have the capability of registering individuals for up to 14 nights on a first-come, first-served basis provided space is available. Since the registration procedure will also be computerized, a registration fee of \$2.75 for campsites will be charged.

**Check in time:** Campers may check in from 12:00 noon to 9:00 p.m., but must register and occupy their campsite by 9:00 p.m. on the first night of their reservation or the campsite will be subject to re-rental and fees may be forfeited.

**Check-out time:** Campers must vacate their campsite no later than 11 a.m. on the final day.

**Site Assignment:** Sites are assigned at the campground on a first-come, first-served basis. For those campgrounds that are site specific (see reverse), your selection of a site will occur during the reservation process.

**Length of Stay:** For Department of Environmental Conservation sites, your camping permit can be issued for a maximum of two weeks. From July 1 through Labor Day only 14 cumulative nights of camping can be obtained at any campground. The 14 night limit may be extended at the facility depending on site availability. This is to ensure that new campers can enjoy their right to camp.

**Camping Regulations**

Please take a few moments to acquaint yourself with some of the rules for camping at New York State facilities.

- All campsites must be registered and occupied by a responsible person 18 years of age or older. Persons under 18 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by someone 18 years of age or older who has been issued a permit for that campsite. The permit holder must be in residence at the campsite throughout the permit period.

- Campsite occupancy is limited to 6 persons and two tents or one unit of hard wheeled camping equipment and one tent.
- Quiet hours are strictly enforced from 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. Persons not listed on the permit are not allowed on the campsite during these hours.
- Two vehicles are allowed per site. Additional vehicles will be charged a daily fee and cannot be parked at the site.
- One Boat is permitted per site at Lake George Islands campgrounds

### Pets

- Domesticated household pets are permitted in most DEC campgrounds.
- Where pets are allowed, the actual certificate of current rabies vaccination as issued by a veterinarian is required as proof that the pet has been vaccinated. Dated collar tags will no longer be accepted as proof of the vaccination.
- Dogs may be walked on a leash no longer than 6' in length as long as the dog is under control. Dogs cannot be left unattended and are not allowed in day use areas including picnic areas, facility structures, or beach areas.
- No dogs are permitted in the Lake George Islands or the Watonian Group out of Rogers Rock.
- Dogs cannot be left alone and must be leashed and confined at all times.

### Access Pass

- When calling to make a reservation it is your responsibility to inform the operator that you are an access pass holder.
- When you check in at the campground you must present your access pass and a second form of photo identification.
- When checking out a refund application MUST be filled out by the access pass holder to begin the refund process.
- The access pass holder must be in residence at the campsite throughout the reservation period. Failure to comply with these requirements will result in ineligibility for a refund and possible revocation of the pass.
