Governor Cuomo's Executive Order

- ☐ Signed Jan. 28, 2014 - directs DEC, DOT, NYS Division of Homeland Security and Emergency Services, DOH and NYSERDA to assess the State's spill prevention, response rules and inspection programs for the transportation of crude by rail, ship or barge**
- ☐ Report is due April 30**
- ☐ Jan. 28, 2014 – Agencies petition federal officials to reduce risks to communities**
