

You can help waterbirds and other wildlife by using non-lead fishing tackle.

• Lead fishing tackle can be harmful to wildlife. Waterbirds can die from lead poisoning when they ingest lead fishing sinkers that are mistaken for food or grit.



 Beginning in May 2004, the sale of lead sinkers weighing 0.5 ounces or less will be banned in New York State.

Non-lead sinkers work well and are not harmful to you or wildlife. So, please use non-lead alternatives such as steel, tin, bismuth, ceramic or plastic, and properly dispose of old lead sinkers.
