

# Buffalo River Restoration

The Buffalo River is undergoing a restoration project that involves dredging to remove contaminated sediment from the River.

# Be Safe During River Dredging!

## Seven Watercraft “Rules of the Road”

1. Do not go near barges, machinery and monitoring equipment.
2. Stay *at least* 100 feet away from the barge and tug.
3. Stay to the right of moving barges and tugs.
4. Do not pass moving barges or tugs. Pass stationary barges or tugs in single file line with no wake.
5. Watercraft going up the river yield to watercraft going down the river (toward Lake Erie).
6. Move as far as possible to the side of the navigation channel and stop motion while barges or tugs pass if they need room.
7. Do not stop near a barge or tug for any reason.
