
Buffalo River Restoration

The Buffalo River is undergoing a restoration project that involves dredging to remove contaminated sediment from the River.



Be Safe During River Dredging!

Seven Watercraft "Rules of the Road"

- 1. Do not go near barges, machinery and monitoring equipment.
- 2. Stay at least 100 feet away from the barge and tug.
- 3. Stay to the right of moving barges and tugs.
- 4. Do not pass moving barges or tugs. Pass stationary barges or tugs in single file line with no wake.
- 5. Watercraft going up the river yield to watercraft going down the river (toward Lake Erie).
- 6. Move as far as possible to the side of the navigation channel and stop motion while barges or tugs pass if they need room.



7. Do not stop near a barge or tug for any reason.
