

# How to Find 2013 American Community Survey Data for the Engineering Planning Grant

The following steps will help you find the **Population** estimates for a specific community for the New York State DEC/EFC Wastewater Infrastructure Engineering Planning Grant.

## 1. Go to U.S. Census Bureau's American FactFinder web page:

## 2. To narrow your search to a specific community:

- a. In the **Community Facts** search box in the upper left part of the page, begin typing the name of the community.






