


## PROJECT LOCATION

The project is located in the City of Owego, Tioga County, New York.



## **PROJECT DESCRIPTION**

The project provides for clearing an area of approximately 70 acres along Owego Creek extending from its mouth upstream 1.7 miles to the upper dam, improving sections of the channel, clearing on the left bank of the Susquehanna River near the mouth of the Owego Creek, and clearing of Squaw Island downstream.

## **AUTHORIZATION**

The project was authorized pursuant to Section 212 of the Flood Control Act approved May 17<sup>th</sup>, 1950.

## **CONSTRUCTION**

Construction of the project was completed in August 1952. The Federal cost was \$40,000. The approximate cost to local interests was \$9,100 for land, right-of-way, and utility relocations.
