BIRD BREEDER LICENSE APPLICATION

Instructions

STATUTORY AUTHORITY: Environmental Conservation Law (ECL), Section 11-1728 and 6 NYCRR Parts 174 and 175.

These instructions are designed to serve as an aid to the applicant for completing the Bird Breeder License Application (Form 82-19-37). The instructions correspond numerically with the numbers on the application. When completing the application, please provide sufficient detail to fully answer the questions. The answers you provide are the criteria for approving or denying your license. Incomplete or vague applications will be returned to the applicant.

If approved for a license, your answers on this application will constitute an integral part of your license and you will be expected to adhere to the statements made on your application.

1. Name of applicant.
2. If applying as a business or organization list the name of the business.
3. Mailing address and county of residence of the applicant.
4. Day and night telephone number of the applicant.
5. Date of birth of the applicant.
6. Address where the birds will be housed and bred if different than the mailing address of the applicant.
7. Check the appropriate box.
8. If renewing your Bird Breeder License please provide your previous license number.
9. The DEC may maintain a list of individuals who have been issued a Bird Breeder License. If you would like your name to appear on this list, check the box marked YES. If not, check the box marked NO.
10. When describing the purpose for which you are applying for a Bird Breeder License, provide sufficient detail to enable the Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) to determine whether the birds will be used for bona fide breeding purposes.
11. Provide the number and species, by common and scientific name (genus species), of the birds to be held for breeding purposes. Please attach additional sheets if necessary.
12. Provide a detailed description of your breeding and housing facilities to enable the DEC to determine if your facilities are sufficient and adequate for breeding and raising captive birds of the species listed by you in Number 11 of your application.
13. Please describe in detail the measures you will provide to ensure humane treatment and the probability of successful breeding and raising the species you listed in Number 11 of your application.
14. Provide sufficient detail, including the species and number bred, to enable the DEC to determine, by virtue of your background, if you can reasonably be expected to humanely and successfully breed and raise the birds of the species you listed in Number 11 of your application.
15. Self explanatory.
16. You may provide additional information in this space. Please list the number of the question you are answering when you use this space.

The fee for a Bird Breeder License is \$100.00. The license is valid for five (5) years.

IMPORTANT: Please read the NOTICE section of the application before you sign and date your application.
