ACTION THIS MONTH

- ARCADIS prepared a project contact list using the guidance presented in the New York State
 Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) document titled "DER-23 / Citizen
 Participation Handbook for Remedial Programs" (January 21, 2010) and "Citizen Participation
 Support Materials" (January 2010) and provided the list to Bayer for review.
- Bayer received comments from the NYSDEC on the revised "draft" Corrective Measures Study (CMS)
 Report in November 17, 2011 e-mail correspondence. Bayer and ARCADIS reviewed the comments
 and started revising the report.
- Bayer received comments from the NYSDEC on the "draft" Proposed Remedial Action Plan (PRAP)
 Exhibits A through E in November 18, 2011 e-mail correspondence. Bayer and ARCADIS reviewed the comments and began revising the Exhibits.
- Bayer participated in a November 29, 2011 project update/strategy meeting in Melville, New York with the NYSDEC, New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH), Township of Oyster Bay, New South Road Realty (NSRR), and ARCADIS to discuss the Agency comments on the CMS and PRAP, project status, upcoming events, and actions needed for achieve site closure in 2012.

DELIVERABLES THIS MONTH

No project-related deliverables were submitted to the NYSDEC or NYSDOH in November 2011.

ACTION NEXT MONTH

- Revise the CMS Report based on NYSDEC comments and submit the final document to the NYSDEC and document repository.
- Revise the PRAP Exhibits based on NYSDEC comments and submit the revised document to the NYSDEC and NYSDOH.
- Complete the project contact list and send it to the NYSDEC.
- Schedule an aerial fly-over of the Site for development of a topographic map to document topography
 prior to construction of the final remedial measure.
