DECLARATION of COVENANTS and RESTRICTIONS

WHEREAS, the Northeast Alloys and Metals, Inc. site is the subject of a remedial program performed by the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (the "Department"), namely that parcel of real property located on 2145 Dwyer Avenue in the City of Utica, County of Oneida, State of New York, which is part of lands conveyed by Utica Urban Renewal Agency to Cobblestone Construction, LLC by deed dated December 19, 2007 and recorded in the Oneida County Clerk's Office on December 21, 2007 in Instrument No. 2007-25635, and being more particularly described in Appendix "A," attached to this declaration and made a part hereof, and hereinafter referred to as "the Property"; and

WHEREAS, the Department approved a remedy to eliminate or mitigate all significant threats to the environment presented by the contamination disposed at the Property and such remedy requires that the Property be subject to restrictive covenants.

NOW, THEREFORE, Cobblestone Construction, LLC, for itself and its successors and/or assigns, covenants that:

First, the Property subject to this Declaration of Covenants and Restrictions is as shown on a map attached to this declaration as Appendix "B" and made a part hereof.

Second, unless prior written approval by the Department or, if the Department shall no longer exist, any New York State agency or agencies subsequently created to protect the environment of the State and the health of the State's citizens, hereinafter referred to as "the Relevant Agency," is first obtained, where contamination remains at the Property subject to the provisions of the Site Management Plan ("SMP"), there shall be no construction, use or occupancy of the Property that results in the disturbance or excavation of the Property which threatens the integrity of the engineering controls or which results in unacceptable human exposure to contaminated soils.

Third, the owner of the Property shall not prevent access by the Department or its agents to the property nor disturb, remove, or otherwise interfere with the installation, use, operation, and maintenance of engineering controls required for the Remedy, which are described in the
