DESCRIPTION OF WORK PERFORMED:

AM The prime contractor Oswego County delivered barrier protection material (common fill) to the slope along Silk Road using ATV dump trucks. It was spread over the type 1 geotextile by a low ground pressure dozer and compacted with a vibratory roller. They tried to deploy geotextile over select fill also on the Silk Road slope. Wind was too strong. Select fill was delivered to the Silk Road slope by both ATV dump truck and 10 wheel dump truck. It was spread over the 40 mil. cap by a low ground pressure dozer. Wet top soil was removed from the inside of the perimeter road curve in the Southwest of the existing capped area. This material was hauled to the top soil stockpile.

Three laborers from Antanna Liners made repairs to the cap at the intersection of the phase 3 and phase 4 capping areas. The cap had to be cut to make repairs to the subgrade soil erosion that occurred after the cap was installed.

PM The prime contractor Oswego County delivered barrier protection material (common fill) to the North slope using ATV dump trucks. It was spread over the type 1 geotextile by a low ground pressure dozer and compacted with a vibratory roller. Geotextile was deployed over select fill near the type II trench on the Phase 1 slope. The pieces of geotextile was sewn together. The slope to the East (Silk Road) that has had the top soil removed was regraded, had some sand added, and compacted. Anchor trench was excavated at the toe of the slope on the Silk Road side of the project. Refuse excavated from the anchor trench and that brought to the surface by the gas vent drilling was hauled to the low area on the slope Northwest of the office trailer, dumped and graded. The anchor trench at the toe of the South slope was filled.

A subcontractor, Moretrench, installed gas vents on the phase 3 capping area.

A Barton & Loquidice field engineer was on site to over see the County's work.

It was spread over the textured HDPE cap with a low ground pressure dozer and compacted with a vibratory roller. Samples were collected and sent to the CME Lab for gradation testing. The slope to the South that has had the top soil removed was regraded, had some sand added, and compacted. Additional anchor trench was excavated at the intersection of the old cap and the new cap on the South slope. Concrete fence post anchors were removed along the Silk Road side of the site. A water truck was used to wet down the haul roads to reduce dust.

PM The prime contractor Oswego County stripped topsoil from the East slope near the field trailers, loaded it onto dump trucks and hauled it to the North portion of the site to stockpile. Sand was delivered to the North slope by the County's ATV dump trucks. It was spread over the textured HDPE cap by a low ground pressure dozer and compacted with a vibratory roller. Patches were glued to the 20 mil cap that had been damaged during exposure and after it was redeployed over the refilled anchor trench at the intersection of the new and old cap. A type 2 drainage swale was excavated in the Southwest corner of the site. The refuse excavated was hauled to the East slope and dumped in a low area to be recovered. The 20 mil cap exposed on the South slope was power washed to remove cover soil without cutting holes in the material. A water truck was used to wet down the haul roads to reduce dust.
