CBS Corporation (CBS), formerly known as Viacom Inc., hereby submits this quarterly status report and notification to the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA), Region II, pursuant to the appropriate paragraphs of the Unilateral Administrative Order for Remedial Design and Remedial Action (RD/RA), Index No. II CERCLA-10219.

1. Actions Taken During Previous Quarter to Achieve Compliance with Order

- A. On January 8, 2014, CBS submitted a quarterly status report and notification to EPA and the New York State Department of Conservation (NYSDEC).
- B. The Barrier Well water treatment facility (WTF) operated throughout the first quarter of 2014. The estimated average flow from the Barrier Wells during the quarter was approximately 1,316 gallons per minute (gpm). Discharge has been both to the plant production facility and directly to the State Pollutant Discharge Elimination System (SPDES) outfall.
- C. The Elmira Water Board did not report the operation of the Kentucky Avenue Well WTF for the period.

2. Results of Sampling and Tests and Other Data

- A. No additional data (besides the routine SPDES monitoring reported to NYSDEC and operational data) were developed for the first quarter of 2014 reporting period.

3. Actions Projected for the Second Quarter of 2014

- A. CBS anticipates that operation of the Barrier Wells and the WTF will be discontinued during the month of April 2014. At that time CBS will begin following the Revised Closure Monitoring Plan for Operable Unit 2 dated January 7, 2014.

4. Progress and Schedule Report

- A. The work activities defined in the RD Work Plan and the RA Work Plan are 100 percent completed. O&M activities are underway.
