GENERAL COMMENTS:

As part of the of the NYSDEC-approved Remedial Action Work Plan, Roux Environmental Engineering and Geology D.P.C. (Roux) performed environmental oversight and operated air monitoring equipment in compliance with the Community Air Monitoring Plan (CAMP) during foundation installation activities.

RAWP Activities Performed:

- Kingdom backfilled in grids A1 and B1 around foundation elements, as necessary.
- Kingdom continued the installation of foundation elements.
- Kingdom poured concrete for the foundation in grids A1 and B1.

CAMP Performed:

- CAMP was not performed today due to precipitation. Conditions at the site were wet and no fugitive dust was observed to be traveling offsite.

Other Relevant Comments or Issues:

- None.

Upcoming work activities:

- Installation of SOE and deeper foundation elements (footings, piers, pile caps, etc.) expected to continue throughout the site area through October 2022. Localized excavation will occur, as necessary.
- Roux will continue oversight, performance of CAMP during intrusive construction activities, and collecting soil documentation end point samples as required by the RAWP.

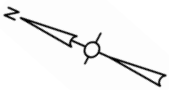
