Furthermore, upon executing its purchase agreement, Requestor reached out to DEC promptly to obtain a full understanding of the existing environmental conditions, and what remedial actions Requestor should take to satisfy DEC requirements. Upon taking title Requestor will exercise appropriate care and take reasonable steps with regard to existing contamination.
