PHASE I ENVIRONMENTAL SITE ASSESSMENT

A. INTRODUCTION

EPDSCO, Inc., has performed a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment (ESA) of the property located at 532-542, 577-599 Union Street and 493-499 President Street, in the Borough of Brooklyn in the City of New York. This ESA was prepared in accordance with the ASTM Standard Practice for Environmental Site Assessments: Phase I Environmental Site Assessment Process (ASTM Designation E 1527-05).

The purpose of this ESA is to identify, to the extent feasible in accordance with ASTM E 1527-05, recognized environmental conditions in connection with the site with regard to hazardous materials as defined by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA), and petroleum products. Additionally, several ASTM "Non-Scope" items including asbestos-containing materials, lead-based paints, and radon are also discussed. Recognized Environmental Conditions are identified through research into the history and uses of the site and surrounding area, an inspection of the subject property and a survey of adjoining and nearby uses, and a review of available regulatory agency records and environmental databases. A detailed scope of work is included in Section IV of this report. Sanborn atlases, historical aerial photographs and other pertinent figures are included in Attachment A. Photographs are located in Attachment B. Regulatory agency database information from Environmental Data Resources, Inc. (EDR) is included in Attachment C, and the City Directory Abstract reports, also provided by Environmental Data Resources, Inc., is included in Attachment D.

B. EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

The subject property consists of nine lots located on two adjoining city blocks. The property is occupied by Milso Industries, which was formerly known as the South Brooklyn Casket Company. Operations at the subject property consists of warehousing, sale and distribution of caskets, as well as typical office activities associated with these operations.

The southern part of the property (i.e., located on Block 440) consists of seven adjoining lots totaling approximately 16,000 square feet in area.

- Lot 21 contains a two-story and basement masonry and wood frame building at 532 Union Street, a three-story and basement masonry and wood frame building at 534 Union Street, and a two-story, masonry and wood frame building at 493 President Street.
- Lot 23 contains a one-story, masonry and wood frame building at 536 Union Street.
- Lot 24 contains a one-story, masonry and wood frame building at 538 Union Street.
- Lot 25 contains a one-story and basement, masonry and wood frame building at 540 Union Street.
- Lot 26 contains a one-story, masonry and wood frame building at 542 Union Street.
- Lot 47 contains a one-story, masonry and wood frame building at 499 President Street.
- Lot 48 contains a one-story, masonry and wood frame building at 495-497 President Street.

All of these adjoining structures have been interconnected for ease of access by the company. The first floor of the buildings contain warehousing space for caskets and for truck parking. The second floor areas contain office and showroom space. The third floor area contains a single residential apartment. The three basement areas are used for file storage.

The northern part of the property (i.e., located on Block 433) consists of two adjoining lots containing a total area of approximately 38,000 square feet.

- Lot 28 contains a 34,000 square foot, one-story, masonry and wood frame warehouse type structure with a small partial basement area on the southwest portion of the building (approximately 1,000 square feet). This building contains a concrete slab floor. Most of the space in the building is used for the warehousing of caskets. The rest of the space contains a small office area, casket repair area, and casket upholstery shop.
- Lot 46 contains a 4,000 square foot, one-story, masonry and wood frame warehouse building used for casket storage.

Research into the history of the subject property indicates that the southern part of the site has been occupied by various commercial, manufacturing, and auto-related uses since at least the early 1900s. Identified former occupants of this portion of the property whose operations typically involve the storage or use of hazardous materials/petroleum products include casket manufacturing (including painting), auto body manufacturing and repair, an automobile repair

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garage, and possibly the dumb waiter factory, in addition to woodworking operations and engravers.

The northern part of the subject property has also been historically occupied by commercial, industrial, and auto-related uses. Identified former uses on the northern part of the property which typically involve the storage or use of hazardous materials include a lumber yard paint shop, automobile repair operations, a machine shop, and a chemical business (House of Chemicals listed at 577 Union Street in 1949). Any past spills or leaks of hazardous materials or petroleum products from past on-site operations involving the storage or use of these materials would be a potential source of contamination to the subject property.

An underground storage tank vent line was observed protruding from the roof of the subject building at 581-599 Union Street at the time of the site visit. According to Mr. Michael Pontone, there was formerly a small underground gasoline tank below the floor in this building which was taken out of service and closed many years ago. A concrete patch was observed in the floor of the building over the tank location at the time of the site visit. The 1938 through 1981 Sanborn maps also show this tank in the building. Any past spills or leaks of gasoline from this tank would be a potential source of contamination to the subject property.

There were not any additional tank vent lines, fillports, or other indications of the presence of underground storage tanks observed at the subject property during the site visit. The 1938 Sanborn map shows the presence of five small oil tanks located in the building at 581-599 Union Street. There were not any indications of these tanks noted during the site inspection and it is possible that they were aboveground oil tanks associated with the automobile repair operations conducted in the building at that time.

According to Mr. Pontone, the subject building at 581-599 Union Street was formerly heated by an oil-fired system located in the small basement area on the west side of the building. The tank for this system was located aboveground and was removed from the site many years ago. No oil tanks or boilers were observed in the basement area of the building at the time of the site visit.

The subject property does not appear in the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation's (NYSDEC) Petroleum Bulk Storage (PBS) database, which lists all registered facilities with a total combined petroleum storage capacity in excess of 1,100 gallons.

Approximately 250 linear feet of suspected asbestos-containing pipe insulation was observed in the subject building at 581-599 Union Street during the site visit. Additionally, any roofing materials on the subject buildings which have not been replaced since the 1970s could also contain asbestos.

Given the age of the subject buildings, it is possible that they contain lead-based paints in areas which have not been renovated since the 1970s. The office areas of the buildings on the southern portion of the property have recently been renovated and painted surfaces in these areas were observed to be in good condition.

According to a review of Sanborn historical maps, land uses in the area of the subject property have generally been a mix of predominantly industrial, commercial and auto-related (i.e., repair shops, filling stations, etc.) from at least the early 1900s to the 1970s. Identified former uses in the area include metal manufacturing companies, the Brooklyn Union Gas Fulton Municipal Branch

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(formerly located on the block adjacent to the northern portion of the subject property), gasoline filling stations and auto repair garages, wood products manufacturing, bottling companies, fuel companies and numerous garages/warehouses with underground gasoline tanks. There are a total of 51 leaking tank spill incidents listed within a ½ mile radius of the subject property, 11 of which have not been designated as closed by the NYSDEC (see Attachment C). In addition to the leaking tank spill incidents, there are 44 spill incidents of other causes listed within ½ mile of the subject property, four of which have not been closed. Given the past industrial and auto-related uses and the number of underground tanks and reported spill incidents in the area surrounding the subject site, the potential for subsurface contamination exists in the area of the subject property.

Conclusions

We have performed a Phase I Environmental Site Assessment in conformance with the scope and limitations of ASTM Practice E 1527-05 of 532-542 and 577-599 Union Street and 493-499 President Street, Brooklyn, N.Y., the property. Any exceptions to or deletions from this standard are described in section A. of this report. This assessment has revealed no evidence of recognized environmental conditions in connection with the property, with the following exceptions:

- The potential for site contamination from identified former on-site uses which typically involved the storage or use of hazardous materials/petroleum products.
- The potential for contamination from any past spills or leaks from the underground gasoline tank located below the subject building at 581-599 Union Street.
- The possible presence of asbestos-containing materials and lead based paints in the subject buildings.
- The potential for contamination from former off-site manufacturing operations and leaks from underground storage tanks in the area surrounding the subject property.

The subject site is located on the two adjoining blocks bound by Sackett Street to the north, President Street to the south, 3rd Avenue to the east and Nevins Street to the west, in the Borough of Brooklyn in the City of New York. The property appears on the USGS 7.5 Minute Series Topographic Map Brooklyn, New York Quadrangle (see Attachment A).

Site Description

The subject property consists of nine lots located on two adjoining city blocks. The property is occupied by Milso Industries, which was formerly known as the South Brooklyn Casket Company. Operations at the subject property consists of warehousing, sale and distribution of caskets, as well as typical office activities associated with these operations.

The southern part of the property (i.e., located on Block 440) consists of seven adjoining lots totaling approximately 16,000 square feet in area.

 Lot 21 contains a two-story and basement masonry and wood frame building at 532 Union Street, a three-story and basement masonry and wood frame building at 534 Union Street, and a two-story, masonry and wood frame building at 493 President Street.

- Lot 23 contains a one-story, masonry and wood frame building at 536 Union Street.
- Lot 24 contains a one-story, masonry and wood frame building at 538 Union Street.
- Lot 25 contains a one-story and basement, masonry and wood frame building at 540 Union Street.
- Lot 26 contains a one-story, masonry and wood frame building at 542 Union Street.
- Lot 47 contains a one-story, masonry and wood frame building at 499 President Street.
- Lot 48 contains a one-story, masonry and wood frame building at 495-497 President Street.

All of these adjoining structures have been interconnected for ease of access by the company. The first floor of the buildings contain warehousing space for caskets and for truck parking. The second floor areas contain office and showroom space. The third floor area contains a single residential apartment. The three basement areas are used for file storage.

The northern part of the property (i.e., located on Block 433) consists of two adjoining lots containing a total area of approximately 38,000 square feet.

- Lot 28 contains a 34,000 square foot, one-story, masonry and wood frame warehouse type structure with a small partial basement area on the southwest portion of the building (approximately 1,000 square feet). This building contains a concrete slab floor. Most of the space in the building is used for the warehousing of caskets. The rest of the space contains a small office area, casket repair area, and casket upholstery shop.
- Lot 46 contains a 4,000 square foot, one-story, masonry and wood frame warehouse building used for casket storage.

Site History

Information regarding site history was obtained from a variety of standard historical sources including historical land use/fire insurance atlases such as those produced by Sanborn, Bromley and/or Belcher Hyde, New York City Buildings Department information including Certificates of Occupancy (CO), Building Permits, Alteration Permits, etc., and interviews with site owners, occupants or local residents. Additionally, historical aerial photographs of the site and a city directories abstract search was obtained from EDR, Inc.

<u>Historical Maps</u>

The 1886, 1904, 1915, 1938, 1950, 1969, 1977, 1979, 1980, 1981, 1982, 1986, 1987, 1988, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1995 and 1996 Sanborn fire insurance/real estate maps were reviewed (see Attachment A). These maps provide information on the history of structures at the site, property use including operations involving the storage or use of hazardous materials, and may show the presence of buried gasoline tanks.

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Block 440, Lot 21 (532-534 Union Street & 493 President Street)

The 1886 Sanborn maps shows a small, three-story residential dwelling on the 493 President Street portion of this lot, and the remainder of the lot appears as vacant land. The 1904 Sanborn map shows a two-story structure occupied by a carriage house on the first floor and a residential dwelling on the second floor at the 532 Union Street portion of the lot. A two-story retail store with a detached one-story summer kitchen appears on the 534 Union Street portion of the lot on the 1904 Sanborn map. A three-story retail store and a one-story building for the storage of rags appear at 493 President Street on the 1904 Sanborn map. A two-story building occupied by a carriage house on the 1st floor and a dwelling on the second floor appears at 532 Union Street on the 1915 Sanborn map. A two-story building occupied by a dumb waiter factory on the 1st floor and a dwelling on the second floor appears at 534 Union Street on the 1915 Sanborn map. A three-story retail store and a small one-story shed appear at 493 President Street on the 1915 Sanborn map. The 1938 Sanborn map shows a two-story building used for casket storage at 532 Union Street. A two-story building for sash and door storage on the 1st floor and a dwelling on the second floor appears at 534 Union Street on the 1938 Sanborn map. 493 President Street appears as vacant land on the 1938 Sanborn map. The 1950 through 1996 Sanborn maps show a two-story building at 532 Union Street and a three-story building at 534 Union Street, both of which are used for casket storage. A twostory building with a private garage on the 1st floor and casket storage on the second floor appears at 493 President Street on the 1950 Sanborn map. The operations in this building are shown as woodworking on the 1969 through 1996 Sanborn maps.

Block 440, Lot 23 (536 Union Street)

This lot appears as vacant land with no identified on-site operations on the 1886 and 1904 Sanborn maps. A small, one-story retail building (shown as vacant) appears on the 1915 Sanborn map. A one-story building which contains painting operations is shown on the 1938 and 1950 Sanborn maps. The operations in this building are shown as casket manufacturing on the 1969 through 1996 Sanborn maps.

Block 440, Lot 24 (538 Union Street)

This lot appears as vacant land with no identified on-site operations on the 1886 Sanborn map. A one-story building used for hay storage appears on the 1904 Sanborn map. A one-story building used for a wagon house appears on the 1915 Sanborn map. A one-story building for wagon and auto body manufacturing is shown on the 1938 and 1950 Sanborn maps. The operations in this building are shown as casket manufacturing on the 1969 through 1996 Sanborn maps.

Block 440, Lot 25 (540 Union Street)

This lot appears as vacant land with no identified on-site operations on the 1886 Sanborn map. A two-story building used for hay and feed storage appears on the 1904 and 1915 Sanborn maps. A one-story building with no specified uses are shown on the 1938 Sanborn map. A one-story building for casket storage is shown on the 1950 Sanborn map. The operations in this building are shown as casket manufacturing on the 1969 through 1996 Sanborn maps.

Block 440, Lot 26 (542 Union Street)

This lot appears as vacant land with no identified on-site operations on the 1886 Sanborn map. A three-story building with a coach house on the first floor and a residential dwelling on the second and third floors appears on the 1904 and 1915 Sanborn maps. A three-story building with sash and door storage on the first floor and dwellings on the second and third floors appears on the 1938 Sanborn map. A one-story building used for casket storage appears on the 1950 through 1996 Sanborn maps.

Block 440, Lot 47 (499 President Street)

The 1886 Sanborn map shows a small, one-story residential dwelling on this lot. Two small, one-story sheds appear on the 1904 and 1915 Sanborn maps. A one-story wagon house and stable appear on the 1938 Sanborn map. A one-story building for general storage and unspecified commercial operations appear on the 1950 through 1996 Sanborn maps.

Block 440, Lot 48 (495-497 President Street)

The 1886 Sanborn map shows a small, two-story dwelling and a small one-story dwelling on the 495 President Street portion of the lot, and a small, two-story dwelling on the 497 President Street portion of the lot. A three-story retail store and three, small one-story sheds appear at 495 President Street on the 1904 and 1915 Sanborn maps. A three-story retail store and a three-story dwelling appear at 497 President Street on the 1904 map and 1915 Sanborn maps. A one-story retail store and a small, one-story detached shed appear at 495 President Street, and a three-story store and two-story dwelling appear at 497 President Street on the 1938 Sanborn map. The 1950 Sanborn map shows a three-story retail building at 495 President Street, and a three-story retail building with a vacant, three-story accessory structure at 497 President Street. A one-story building used for woodworking appears on this entire lot on the 1969 through 1996 Sanborn maps.

Block 433, Lot 28 (581-599 Union St.)

The 1886 Sanborn map shows this lot occupied by the Kenyon & Newton Timber Yard. There are not any structures shown at this lot on the 1886 Sanborn map. The 1904 and 1915 Sanborn maps show this lot occupied by the Albro J. Newton Timber Yard, and indicates timber stored throughout the lot. There are not any buildings shown on the 1904 or 1915 Sanborn maps. The building which currently resides at this lot appears on all of the remaining Sanborn maps reviewed. The 1938 Sanborn map indicates that it was occupied by the New York City Fire Department (NYCFD) as a garage and store house for the telegraph department. Automobile repair operations are indicated in the building and a gasoline tank and five small oil tanks appear in the south/central part of the building. The 1950, 1969, 1977 1979, 1980 and 1981 Sanborn maps show the building occupied by the NYCFD Telegraph Bureau for storage and a garage. A gasoline tank appears in the south/central part of the building on these maps. The 1982 through 1996 Sanborn maps show this building occupied by the South Brooklyn Casket Company.

Block 433, Lot 46 (577-579 Union St.)

The 1886 Sanborn map shows this lot occupied by the Kenyon & Newton Timber Yard. A two-story paint shop is shown on the northern portion of the lot on this map. The 1904 Sanborn map shows that this lot was then part of the Albro J. Newton Timber Yard. A two-story lumber shed appears on the southern portion of the lot, and a two-story building for storage and blind painting appears on the northern portion of the lot. The 1915 Sanborn map shows the same occupant and structures, however, both buildings are shown as lumber sheds on this map. A one-story building used for water distilling is shown on the 1938 Sanborn map. The 1950 Sanborn map shows a one-story building used for water distilling and a one-story building occupied by a machine shop. The 1969 Sanborn map shows a one-story building for water distilling and a one-story building used for general storage. The 1977 through 1996 Sanborn maps show a one-story building used for unspecified manufacturing operations.

N.Y.C. Department of Buildings

New York City Department of Buildings on-line Building Information System records were reviewed for Certificates of Occupancy (CO), New Building permits, Demolition permits and other pertinent information regarding the subject property.

Block 440, Lot 21

CO #159968 was issued to this lot on 4/1/58. Permissible uses listed on the CO include storage, cutting room, assembling, display and office. CO #194264 was issued on 3/1/66. Permissible uses listed on this CO include accessory storage, assembly of caskets, showroom, offices and one-family dwelling on the third floor.

Block 440, Lot 23

CO #57654 was issued to this lot on 9/7/29 for a repair shop for automobile bodies.

Block 440, Lot 24

There were not any COs, Demolition Permits, New Building permits or other pertinent information regarding site history found on file for this lot.

Block 440, Lot 25

There were not any COs, Demolition Permits, New Building permits or other pertinent information regarding site history found on file for this lot.

Block 440, Lot 26

CO #191966 was issued to this lot on 6/11/65. Permissible uses listed on the CO are manufacturing establishment, wood products (caskets), storage and spraying. Demolition Permit DEM 48-022549 was issued to the lot in 1940 for the demolition of an unspecified structure at the site. New Building permit NB 468-49 was issued in 1949 for the construction of an unspecified structure at the site.

Block 440, Lot 47

There were not any COs, Demolition Permits, New Building permits or other pertinent information regarding site history found on file for this lot.

Block 440, Lot 48

CO 82792 was issued to this lot on 6/15/37 for a store and two one-family dwellings. Demolition Permit DEM 459-120756 was issued to the lot in 1912 and Demolition permit DEM 241-495 was issued to the lot in 1949, both for the demolition of unspecified structures. New Building permits NB 245-495 (1949) and NB 245-64 (1964) were issued for the construction of unspecified structures on the lot.

Block 433, Lot 28

There were not any COs, Demolition Permits, New Building permits or other pertinent information regarding site history found on file for this lot. Oil Burner Application permit FO 1274/66 was issued on 12/3/66 for the installation of oil burier equipment on the lot.

Block 433, Lot 46

There were not any COs, Demolition Permits, New Building permits or other pertinent information regarding site history found on file for this lot.

Historical Aerial Photographs

Historical aerial photographs for the years 1943, 1954, 1966, 1975, 1984 and 1994 were obtained from Environmental Data Resources, Inc. (see Attachment A). Aerial photographs provide an additional source of information regarding past on-site structures and may show areas of concern including excavations, filling activities, on-site dumping or debris piles, etc.

All of the subject lots appear to be fully occupied by buildings on all of the aerial photographs reviewed. None of the lots appear to be disturbed in any way and there are not any obvious indications of site excavations, debris piles, pits, lagoons, or dumping at any of the lots on any of the aerial photos reviewed.

Interviews

An interview was conducted with Mr. Michael Pontone of Milso Industries. According to Mr. Pontone, the southern portion of the property has been occupied by the South Brooklyn Casket Company (which later became Milso Industries) since at least the 1940s. Historical operations on this part of the site have included the manufacturing, warehousing, painting, sale and display of wooden and steel caskets. The manufacturing of caskets on this part of the site ceased more than 20 years ago and since that time, operations have included importing, warehousing, sale and display of caskets.

According to Mr. Pontone, the subject building at 577-579 Union Street has been occupied by the South Brooklyn Casket Company for warehousing purposes since the 1980s. Prior to this time the building was operated by a water distilling company. The subject building at 581-599 Union Street

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has been occupied by the South Brooklyn Casket Company since the 1980s for warehousing purposes. Prior to the 1980s, this building was occupied by the New York City Fire Department.

City Directories Abstract

A city directories abstract review was performed for the address of the subject property. A city directory abstract is a review of city directories, cross references, and telephone directories which list occupants at a corresponding address. These directories are reviewed at approximately five-year intervals from the 1920s to 2000. The following table lists the findings of the city directory review.

Site Inspection

The subject property was inspected in order to identify potential recognized environmental conditions which may exist at the site. Such conditions include the on-site storage/use of hazardous materials, petroleum storage tanks, asbestos-containing materials, lead-based paints, as well as any visible indications of the past on-site storage/use/disposal of hazardous materials.

Current Operations/Hazardous Materials

The operations at the subject property currently consist of the importing, warehousing, sale and display of caskets, along with associated office activities of the business. The subject building at 581-599 Union Street contains an upholstery shop used to upholster some of the caskets sold by Milso Industries. This building also contains a small repair shop where repairs are performed on damaged casket. These operations include touch-up spray painting. Adhesives and numerous small cans of paint are stored and used in this area. According to Mr. Pontone, there are no wastes generated from these operations, except for some empty cans which are disposed of with the regular garbage. There was not any staining or other indications of past spills or leaks observed in this area at the time of the site visit. Additionally, a paint spray booth and several one-gallon paint cans were observed in the building on the southern part of the site. According to Mr. Pontone, this booth was installed many years ago and was used to paint caskets which were manufactured at the subject property. The booth is still occasionally used for touch up repairs on caskets which have become damaged, however, no paint wastes are generated by these operations. There was not any significant staining or indications of past spills or leaks observed in this area at the time of the site visit.

Drainage Structures

The subject buildings are connected to the municipal sewer system. Several floor drains were observed in the buildings on the southern portion of the site. There was not any staining or other indications of past spills or discharges of hazardous materials/petroleum products around any of the floor drains observed at the site.

Monitoring Wells

There were not any groundwater monitoring wells observed on the site.

Petroleum Storage Tanks

An underground storage tank vent line was observed protruding from the roof of the subject building at 581-599 Union Street at the time of the site visit. According to Mr. Pontone, there was formerly a small underground gasoline tank below the floor in this building which was taken out of service and closed many years ago. A concrete patch was observed in the floor of the building over the tank location at the time of the site visit. The 1938 through 1981 Sanborn maps also show this tank in the building. There were not any additional tank vent lines, fillports or other indications of the presence of additional underground storage tanks observed at the subject

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property during the site visit. The 1938 Sanborn map also shows the presence of five small oil tanks located in the building at 581-599 Union Street. There were not any indications of these tanks noted during the site inspection and it is possible that they were aboveground oil tanks associated with the automobile repair operations conducted in this building at that time.

According to Mr. Pontone, the subject building at 581-599 Union Street was formerly heated by an oil-fired system located in the small basement area on the western side of the building. The tank for this system was located aboveground and was removed from the site many years ago. No oil tanks or boilers were observed in the basement area of the building at the time of the site visit.

The subject property does not appear in the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation's (NYSDEC) Petroleum Bulk Storage (PBS) database, which lists all registered facilities with a total combined petroleum storage capacity in excess of 1,100 gallons.

Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs)

Prior to 1979, PCBs were widely used in electrical equipment such as transformers, capacitors, fluorescent light ballasts, etc., for their cooling and insulating properties. The manufacture, processing and commercial distribution of PCBs was banned in 1979, under the Toxic Substances Control Act (40 CFR Part 761). No electrical transformers or other equipment suspected of containing PCBs were observed on the subject property during our site visit.

Asbestos-Containing Materials/Lead-Based Paints

Asbestos is a natural mineral fiber which was widely used in the manufacture of building and insulating materials prior to the late 1970s, primarily due to its good insulation and mechanical resistance properties. Materials made with asbestos include thermal system insulation (TSI), such as aircell pipe wrap, boiler insulation and breaching, hot water/expansion tank insulation, castable elbow packing, magnesia block insulation, etc., surfacing materials, such as spray-on fire proofing and sound proofing, and miscellaneous materials such as floor tiles and roofing materials.

Approximately 200 linear feet of suspected asbestos-containing pipe insulation were observed in the subject building at 581-599 Union Street during the site visit. Approximately 50 linear feet of suspected asbestos-containing pipe insulation was observed in the small basement area of this building. Additionally, any roofing materials on the subject buildings which have not been replaced since the 1970s could also contain asbestos.

Given the age of the subject buildings, it is possible that they contain lead-based paints. The office areas of the buildings on the southern portion of the property have recently been renovated and painted surfaces in these part of the buildings were observed to be in good condition.

Potable Water Supply

Potable water is supplied to the area of the subject site through the New York City Municipal water supply system, which obtains water from upstate reservoirs. This water is tested on a daily basis at various distribution points.

Surrounding Land Use

Land uses in the area surrounding the subject property are comprised of a mix of commercial, warehousing, light industrial, residential, and retail uses. The subject buildings are currently adjoined by a mix of these uses. According to a review of Sanborn historical maps, land uses in the area were predominantly industrial, commercial, and auto-related (i.e., repair shops, filling stations, etc.) from at least the early 1900s to the 1970s. Identified former uses in the area include metal manufacturing companies, the Brooklyn Union Gas Fulton Municipal Branch (formerly located on the block adjacent to the northern portion of the subject property), gasoline filling stations, and automobile repair garages, wood products manufacturing, bottling companies, fuel companies, and numerous garages/warehouses with underground gasoline tanks.

Regulatory Agency Information and Databases

Regulatory agency environmental database information regarding known or suspected hazardous waste storage or disposal sites, reported spill incidents, registered petroleum storage tanks, solid waste facilities and landfills, etc. for the subject properties and surrounding area is obtained from Environmental Data Resources, Inc. (EDR) of Milford, Ct. These documented sites and incidents are listed in the following section for descriptive purposes. Their inclusion does not necessarily suggest any potential impacts to the subject property, but provides an indication of the potential for general groundwater and soil contamination in the larger area.

Federal Databases

Superfund Sites

The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (USEPA) National Priorities List identifies confirmed hazardous waste sites, (Superfund sites) that are ranked for clean-up under the federal Superfund program. This program was authorized by the Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation, and Liability Act of 1980 (CERCLA).

The subject property is not on the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency's (USEPA) National Priorities List. There are not any USEPA Superfund sites listed within an approximate one mile radius of the subject property.

CERCLIS Sites

A check was made of the USEPA's CERCLA Information System (CERCLIS). The CERCLIS is a comprehensive database and management system that inventories and tracks sites addressed or needing to be addressed by the Superfund program. Sites that the USEPA decide do not warrant further evaluation under the Superfund program are delisted.

The subject site is not on the USEPA's CERCLA Information System (CERCLIS) list. There are two CERCLIS site located within ½ mile of the subject property (see Attachment C). The first site, Vidan Auto Salvage at 321-327 Bond Street, is located more than ½ mile from the subject site. The second site, Brooklyn Union Gas Citizens Gate Station at 2nd Avenue and 6th Street, is located more than ¼ mile from the site. Both of these sites have been given a No Further Remedial Action Planned designation.

RCRA Treatment/Storage/Disposal Facilities

The USEPA's RCRA hazardous waste Treatment/Storage/Disposal (TSD) Facilities database includes facilities that transport, treat, store and/or dispose of hazardous wastes, or have engaged in these activities in the past. TSDF operators, as with hazardous waste transporters or generators, are regulated under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA).

The subject property is not on the USEPA's RCRA hazardous waste TSD Facilities database list. There are not any RCRA TSD facilities listed within ½ mile of the subject property.

RCRA CORRACTS

CORRACTS is a list of hazardous waste handlers with RCRA Corrective Action Activity. This report shows which nationally-defined corrective action core events have occurred for every handler that has had corrective action activity.

The subject property is not on the list. There is one RCRA CORRACTS facility located within one mile of the subject property (see Attachment C). This facility, the Patterson Chemical Co., Inc. at 102 3rd Street, is located more than ¼ mile from the subject property.

RCRA Hazardous Waste Generators

RCRA Hazardous Waste Generators are regulated by the federal government under the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA). An inventory of hazardous waste generators is useful to assess the kinds of hazardous materials/wastes that are handled, stored, and/or transported in the vicinity of the site, as well as on the subject property.

The subject property does not appear in the RCRA Hazardous Waste Generator database. There are nine RCRA small quantity generators listed within 1/8 mile of the subject property. There are not any RCRA large quantity generators listed within 1/8 mile of the subject site.

Emergency Response Notification System

USEPA's Emergency Response Notification System (ERNS) database contains information from federal agencies on CERCLA hazardous substance releases or spills in quantities greater than the reportable quantity.

There are no reported ERNS releases or spills listed at the subject site.

State Databases

Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites

A NYSDEC's Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites Registry contains information on potentially hazardous waste sites in New York State.

The subject property is not included in the Registry. There are not any Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal sites located within one mile of the subject property.

Spill Logs

The NYSDEC Spill Logs database for Region 2 (New York City) was checked for reported spills of toxic or hazardous materials (including petroleum products) within ½ mile of the subject property. Spill incidents listed as "Closed" mean that either records and data submitted indicate that the necessary cleanup and removal actions have been completed and no further remedial activities are necessary, or the case was closed for administrative reasons (e.g., multiple reports of a single spill consolidated into a single spill number). The NYSDEC however reserves the right to require additional remedial work in relation to a spill if in the future it determines that further action is necessary. Spills listed as leaking tanks indicate the possibility of oil or gasoline seepage to the surrounding soils or groundwater. Other spills (i.e., traffic accidents, sloppy housekeeping, equipment failures, etc.) may only affect surface soils.

There are not any NYSDEC-reported spill incidents listed at or adjacent to the subject property. There are a total of 51 leaking tank spill incidents listed within ½ mile radius of the subject property (see Attachment C). Of these, 11 have not been designated as Closed by the NYSDEC. In addition to the leaking tank spill incidents, there are 44 spill incidents of other causes listed within ½ mile of the subject property (see Attachment C). Of these, four have not been designated as Closed by the NYSDEC.

Petroleum Bulk Storage Facilities

A check was made of the most recent NYSDEC Petroleum Bulk Storage (PBS) database. Petroleum bulk storage facilities have petroleum storage capacities in excess of eleven hundred (1,100) gallons, and less than four hundred thousand (400,000) gallons.

The subject property and adjoining properties do not appear in the PBS database.

Solid Waste Facilities

A check was made of the NYSDEC database of solid waste facilities, including, but not limited to, landfills, incinerators, transfer stations, recycling centers.

The subject site is not identified in this database. There are 11 Solid Waste Facility sites located within $\frac{1}{2}$ mile of the subject property (see Attachment C). All eleven of these sites are located more than $\frac{1}{8}$ mile from the subject property.

Radon

Radon, a naturally occurring radioactive gas, is the product of the decay of radium. It is found most frequently in relatively high concentrations in rock formations containing uranium, granite, shale, phosphate, and pitchblende. Radon may also be found in soils contaminated with industrial waste from uranium and phosphate mining. Radon as a gas can move through the soil and water, and into the atmosphere, and is a potential health concern if confined in sufficiently high concentrations in indoor environments. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) has set an "action level" of 4.0 picocuries per liter for continuous long term exposure to radon gas. If radon gas is measured above this level, USEPA suggests follow-up testing and remediation measures.

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According to Federal EPA Radon Information, Kings County (Brooklyn) falls within Radon Zone 3 which has an average indoor radon level below 2 picocuries per liter.

Based on these low average levels for Kings County, it is unlikely that radon gas levels within the subject building exceed the USEPA action level of 4.0 picocuries per liter, and therefore radon testing is typically not recommended.

The subject site is mapped on the USGS 7.5 Minute Topographic Map Brooklyn, N.Y. Quadrangle (1995). The general elevation for the sites is depicted as between 10 and 20 feet above mean sealevel.

D. SCOPE OF WORK

Historical site research is important in the assessment of the likelihood of past releases of hazardous substances (which include petroleum products). Sources of historical information for the subject property include:

- Local library documents (historical maps, aerial photographs, address directories).
- Interviews with site contacts, current site operators, site owners or nearby residents.
- USGS topographic maps, land use and zoning maps, flood plain maps.
- New York City Buildings Department for building history including construction, demolition, and alteration permits.

The following regulatory agency lists and databases of documented hazardous waste sites, waste handlers, and spills are checked for the vicinity of the subject property:

- U.S. Environmental Protection Agency for location of Superfund and CERCLIS sites, ERNS database, and RCRA Hazardous Waste Generators, CORRACTS facilities and TSD facilities.
- New York State Department of Environmental Conservation, Region 2, for spill incidents, Inactive Hazardous Waste Disposal Sites, registered tank lists, Petroleum Bulk Storage sites and Solid Waste Facilities.

The site visit involves a review of current operations, interviews with knowledgeable on-site occupants or building managers, and inspection of accessible areas of the building and inspection of the property for visible indications of any significant contamination by toxic or hazardous materials. The investigation includes the following objectives:

- To identify sources of potential on-site contamination, such as underground storage tanks, dry wells, interior floor drains, transformers (which may contain PCBs), suspected asbestoscontaining materials, and suspected lead-based paints, etc.
- To examine the property for signs of potential contamination: stained soils, unusual odors, stressed or dead vegetation, improperly stored drums, oil slicks, on-site waste disposal/dumping, etc.
- To identify the quantity and type of toxic or hazardous substances (if any) used in the on-site operations.
- To determine if any on-site toxic and hazardous materials are stored, handled and disposed of in accordance with good practice, minimizing the potential for contamination.
- To identify potential off-site sources of contamination. Adjacent uses are noted, particularly auto-related and industrial sites.
- To identify on-site or adjacent off-site sensitive receptors, such as wetlands, surface waters, drinking water wells.

Not all of the objectives described above are applied to every site; investigations are tailored to the particular nature of the site. It should be noted that information requested from regulatory agencies may be incomplete or unavailable within a reasonable time period.






Figure 2 – Subject Property Location 1904 Sanborn Map




Figure 3 – Subject Property Location 1915 Sanborn Map




Figure 4 - Subject Property Location 1938 Sanborn Map




Figure 5 – Subject Property Location 1950 Sanborn Map




Figure 6 - Subject Property Location 1969 Sanborn Map




Figure 7 - Subject Property Location 1979 Sanborn Map




Figure 8 – Subject Property Location 1987 Sanborn Map




Figure 9 - Subject Property Location 1996 Sanborn Map




Figure 10 - Subject Property Location 1943 Aerial Photograph




Figure 12 - Subject Property Location 1966 Aerial Photograph


