#### 1. Introduction

In accordance with the September 9, 2015 Brownfield Site Cleanup Agreement (BCA) for the above-referenced site, Langan Engineering, Environmental, Surveying and Landscape Architecture, D.P.C. (Langan) prepared this monthly progress report, on behalf of Kermit 79, LLC, 7-9-11 Weehawken Street, LLC, and 300 West 10<sup>th</sup> Street, LLC ("Participants"), to summarize the work performed at 173 Christopher Street in New York, New York (the "site") during the month of October 2023.

Also known as Block 636, Lot 34, the site consists of a rectangular-shaped lot encompassing a total of 4,200 square feet (± 0.09 acres). Improvements to the site include a vacant, partitioned three-story commercial/residential building with a full basement. The site building formerly operated as a machine shop between 1921 and 1950. The site is bounded by multi-story mixed residential/commercial buildings to the north; a one story commercial building to the east; Christopher Street to the south, and a four-story mixed residential/commercial building to the west.
