# Project Announcement

# Remedial Action Work Plan for 90-30 Metropolitan Avenue Available for Comment

This fact sheet is being provided to you pursuant to the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation's policies under the Voluntary Cleanup Program. You have been sent this fact sheet because you own or live on property near the 90-30 Metropolitan Avenue Site or because the New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (NYSDEC) believes you may otherwise be interested in activities at the Site. Please contact the NYSDEC's project manager (see the lower-left hand side of this page) if you do not want to receive any future updates on this project.

The goal of this fact sheet is to provide you with a brief overview of this project and, if you are interested, how you can get more information concerning the Remedial Action Work Plan (RAWP). The NYSDEC will accept public comments on the RAWP during the 30-day comment period ending July 28, 2006. Copies of the RAWP and other appropriate documents are available in the site document repositories located at the addresses listed in the box on the left side of this page. The NYSDEC will review the RAWP and public comments and then make a determination on approval of the RAWP.

PROJECT BACKGROUND The 90-30 Metropolitan Avenue Site (Site) is a 1.87-acre commercial property. The Woodhaven Lanes Bowling Alley adjoins the west side of the Site. Metropolitan Avenue bounds the north side of the Site and Trotting Course Lane is present to the east. 73<sup>rd</sup> Avenue bounds the south side of the Site. The existing Site building was constructed in 1951 on former residential/agricultural property and was operated as a pharmaceutical distribution warehouse until 1976. Between 1977 and 1993 the Site was occupied by a manufacturer and distributor of printing presses and parts. Since 1993 the Site has remained vacant until redevelopment activities began in 2005.

The groundwater beneath the southern portion of the Site is impacted by a solvent, tetrachloroethene (PCE). No onsite source of PCE has been identified. A separate plume of contaminated groundwater is associated with the adjoining Woodhaven Lanes Bowling Alley. These plumes co-mingle on the west side of the Site. The onsite plume of impacted groundwater will be cleaned up during redevelopment of the Site. The Site is currently being redeveloped for retail use.

VOLUNTARY CLEANUP PROGRAM (VCP) OVERVIEW New York established its VCP to address the environmental, legal, and financial barriers that often hinder the redevelopment and reuse of contaminated properties and to enhance private sector cleanups. New York's VCP is a cooperative endeavor among NYSDEC, the New York State Department of Health (NYSDOH), and Volunteers to investigate and remediate contaminated sites. Under the VCP, a Volunteer enters into a Voluntary Cleanup Agreement (VCA) with the NYSDEC and thereafter submits one or more work plans to investigate and remediate a site. The goal under the VCP is to remediate sites to a level that is protective of public health and the environment. In 2002, a Voluntary Cleanup Agreement for the Site was entered into between NYSDEC and Titan Management LP (Titan). DPSW Forest Hills LLC (DPSW) purchased the Site from Titan in 2004 and was added as a Co-Volunteer in 2005. DPSW is redeveloping the Site for commercial retail use.

SUMMARY OF THE REMEDIAL ACTION WORK PLAN Soil investigations at the Site have failed to identify an onsite PCE source. PCE and related compounds have been detected in groundwater beneath the Site, which is present between approximately 45 and 133 feet below grade. Concentrations of PCE in groundwater decrease downward. No significant concentrations of PCE are present in soil vapor beneath the Site.

The proposed remedy includes of an air sparge/soil vapor extraction (AS/SVE) system to remediate potential PCE-impacted soil and PCE-impacted groundwater along the southern portion of the Site and to address potential soil vapor intrusion issues. This system will treat the groundwater beneath the Site by removing the PCE. Effluent from the system will be monitored and treated, as necessary. Monitoring of the groundwater, soil vapor, indoor air and system operation will be performed to confirm that remediation is progressing and that exposures are minimized to the Site occupants or surrounding neighborhood.




