


Become a PAPER Pal!



It takes energy and resources to make paper from trees.

For every ton of paper recycled, we can...

- ❖ Reduce carbon dioxide emissions by 850 pounds per year
- ❖ Save 7000 gallons of water
- ❖ Make 60 pounds less air pollution
- ❖ Save 3 cubic yards of landfill space
- ❖ Save 4100 kilowatt hours of energy
- ❖ Save 17 trees
- ❖ Save 463 gallons of oil



YOU CAN HELP STOP GLOBAL CLIMATE CHANGE BY USING LESS PAPER.

How much paper do you use?

Save all of your household paper for one week—newspapers, magazines, junk mail, office paper, etc.—then weigh it.

Multiply this by 52 to estimate how much paper you use in one year. An average of 38.5 pounds each week amounts to 1 ton per year.

What will you do to reduce, reuse and recycle paper from your home? Here are some ideas to get you started.

- ❖ Buy paper made from recycled materials
