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Program Description

The New York State (NYS) Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC or Department) is pleased to announce rebates to municipalities for the purchase or lease of battery electric, plug-in hybrid, and hydrogen fuel cell vehicles for municipal fleet use. Applications are accepted via the Grants Gateway on a rolling basis, and awards are made on a rolling basis within the opportunity availability dates.

Funding for this grant opportunity is provided by the Environmental Protection Fund and administered pursuant to Environmental Conservation Law Article 54, Title 15 and 6 NYCRR Part 492, Climate Smart Community Projects.

Funding Available

A total of \$750,000 is available for the 2022 round of the Municipal ZEV Rebate Program. Of this \$750,000, 40 percent (\$300,000) will be prioritized for rebates to municipal applicants that intersect with at least one Disadvantaged Community, as identified by the Climate Justice Working Group (CJWG) draft criteria. The remainder (\$450,000) is available for all municipalities and eligible projects as discussed and defined herein.

A list of municipalities that intersect with one or more Disadvantaged Communities can be found in Attachment A of this request for applications (RFA). More information about Disadvantaged Communities is below.

Disadvantaged Communities

The Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act (Climate Act) charged the CJWG with the development of criteria to identify Disadvantaged Communities to ensure that frontline and otherwise underserved communities benefit from the State's historic transition to cleaner sources of energy, reduced pollution and cleaner air, and economic opportunities.

The CJWG developed draft criteria to identify census tracts that qualify as Disadvantaged Communities by evaluating 45 indicators, including environmental exposures, burdens, and climate change risks; sociodemographic factors, such as age, race, and income; pollution characteristics; and health vulnerabilities. DEC is committed to meeting or exceeding the requirements of the Climate Act with respect to Disadvantaged Communities, including the requirement in Environmental Conservation Law § 75-0117 that Disadvantaged Communities receive at least 35 percent of the benefits of spending on clean energy and energy efficiency programs, with a goal of 40 percent. Given this important objective of the Climate Act, 40 percent of the available funds for this round will be prioritized for ZEV rebates to municipalities that intersect with at least one Disadvantaged Community, as identified by the CJWG draft criteria.

¹ Public comments on the draft Disadvantaged Communities criteria are currently being accepted through July 7, 2022. While the draft criteria will be utilized for this RFA, once the criteria are finalized, future RFAs will utilize the final criteria.

DEC will make every effort, consistent with this RFA, to prioritize awards to municipalities that intersect with at least one Disadvantaged Community. In the event that awards to projects related to Disadvantaged Communities do not exceed 40 percent of the total available funds, the remaining funds may be awarded to qualified projects from municipalities that do not intersect with at least one Disadvantaged Community.

Eligibility

Eligible Applicants

All municipalities in the State of New York are eligible to apply for funding in response to this RFA. For the purpose of this RFA and pursuant to 6 NYCRR § 492-1.1(j), a municipality is defined as a county, city, town, village, or borough (referring only to Manhattan, Bronx, Queens, Brooklyn, and Staten Island) residing within New York State.

Non-profit and not-for-profit organizations, and political subdivisions such as municipal corporations, school districts, district corporations, boards of cooperative educational services, fire districts, public benefit corporations, industrial development authorities, and similar organizations are not eligible for this rebate program.

Eligible Vehicles

Eligible vehicles (as defined in ECL § 54-1521(1)(c)) include all-electric vehicles, plug-in hybrid electric vehicles, and hydrogen fuel cell vehicles that adhere to all the following criteria:

- They have four wheels.
- They are manufactured for use primarily on public streets, roads, and highways.
- They contain a powertrain that has not been modified from the original manufacturer's specifications.*
- They are rated at not more than 14,000 pounds gross vehicle weight.
- They have a maximum speed capability of at least 55 miles per hour.
- They are propelled, at least in part, by an electric motor (and its associated power electronics) that provide acceleration torque to the drive wheels sometime during normal vehicle operation.
- They draw electricity from a hydrogen fuel cell or from a battery that has a capacity of not less than four kilowatt-hours.
- They are capable of being recharged from an external source of electricity.

***NOTE: Vehicles that have been retrofitted are NOT eligible for a rebate under this program; however, vehicles that have been upfitted are eligible for a rebate.**

Retrofitted vehicles are defined as vehicles that have had the powertrain (engine, transmission, driveshaft, axles, differential) modified, e.g., replaced a gas engine with an electric motor. Upfitted vehicles have an original drive train purchased from a manufacturer.

Vehicles must be placed into municipal service at a dealership located in New York State to be eligible for a rebate through this program.

Project Timeframe

Municipal ZEV Program rebates are available to municipalities that purchased or leased an eligible vehicle and placed it into municipal service at a dealership located within New York between August 1, 2020, and September 30, 2022. If the vehicle is leased, the minimum lease term is 36 months.

Minimum and Maximum Award Amounts

The minimum rebate amount per vehicle is \$2,500. The maximum rebate amount per vehicle is \$7,500.

Rebate amounts cannot be a denomination other than \$2,500, \$5,000, or \$7,500. For example, a request for \$1,000 will not be awarded. The rebate amount cannot exceed the cost of the vehicle minus the value of all applied incentive programs.

For vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating of up to 8,000 pounds, rebates will be issued toward the cost of eligible vehicles on a tiered basis according to the electric range of the vehicle:

- \$2,500 per vehicle for those with an electric range between 50 and 100 miles
- \$5,000 per vehicle for those with an electric range between 101 miles and 200 miles
- \$7,500 per vehicle for those with an electric range of 201 or more miles

For vehicles with a gross vehicle weight rating between 8,001 and 14,000 pounds (e.g., trucks, vans, and minibuses), a rebate of \$7,500 will be issued.

The total of all funding sources may not exceed the total cost of the vehicle(s) purchased. If the applicant is receiving funding from any other rebate or incentive, a copy of the budget breakdown or contract showing all funding received, amount applied to the vehicles for which a rebate is requested, amount to be covered by this program, and amount covered by local funds is required as part of the application.

Application/Award Limit

There is no limit to the number of applications a municipality may file or the number of vehicles for which a municipality may request rebates. However, a maximum of 50 percent of the total available funds (\$375,000) may be awarded to a single municipality. Applications will be accepted until allocated funds are exhausted, DEC withdraws this RFA, or September 30, 2022, whichever comes first.

Match Requirement

There is no match requirement. Applicants must purchase or lease vehicles prior to submitting an application.

Paper or emailed applications will NOT be accepted.

All applicants must be registered in the Grants Gateway at the time and date that the application is due. Applications received from applicants that have not registered in the Grants Gateway by the application due date and time listed at the beginning of this document will not be evaluated and will be disqualified from further consideration.

Grants Gateway Registration

Registration in the Grants Gateway is required to complete an application, enter into a grant contract, amend an existing contract, and to apply for grant reimbursements. The process of registration takes a few weeks and potential applicants are strongly encouraged to begin the Grants Gateway registration process as soon as possible to participate in this grant opportunity.

The individual completing this paperwork will be designated the Grantee Delegated Administrator role in the Grants Gateway. This individual's only responsibility will be to assign and delete roles and responsibilities for other individuals of the organization within the Grants Gateway process flow. The Signatory and the intended project manager should NOT be designated the Delegated Administrator. Vehicle Information

All of the following documentation must be submitted with an application to be eligible for a rebate:

- A list of all vehicles for which rebates are requested, including the vehicle year, make, model, electric range, rebate amount requested, vehicle identification number (VIN), and gross vehicle weight rating.
- Proof of temporary or permanent vehicle registration for each vehicle. For municipal vehicles without a registration, submit a copy of the certificate of origin, MV-50 form, and copy of signed delivery declaration.
- Bill of sale, purchase agreement, or executed and signed vehicle lease (of at least 36 months) for each vehicle clearly showing the vehicle was placed into municipal service at a dealership located in New York State.
- If the applicant is receiving funding from the New York State Energy Research Development Authority's (NYSERDA) Clean Energy Communities (CEC) Program, or any other rebate or incentive program, it is required to submit a copy of the budget

breakdown or contract showing all funding received, amount applied to the vehicle(s) for which a rebate is requested, and balance that the other incentive program funding is not covering.

Expenditure Budget

Applicants must complete a budget in the NYS Grants Gateway. For vehicle rebate requests, show the rebate amount as the Grant Funds in the contractual line and the balance of the cost of the vehicle(s) as Other Funds.

Sexual Harassment Prevention Certification

State Finance Law § 139-I requires all applicants of grant funding to certify that they have a written policy addressing sexual harassment prevention in the workplace and provide annual sexual harassment training (that meets the Department of Labor's model policy and training standards) to all its employees.

Where applying for grant funding is required pursuant to statute, rule, or regulation, every application submitted to the state or any public department or agency of the state must contain the following statement: "By submission of this application, each applicant and each person signing on behalf of the applicant certifies, and in the case of a partnering application each party thereto certifies as to its own organization, under penalty of perjury, that the applicant has and has implemented a written policy addressing sexual harassment prevention in the workplace and provides annual sexual harassment prevention training to all of its employees. Such policy shall, at a minimum, meet the requirements of section two hundred one-g of the labor law." Applications that do not contain the certification will not be considered for award; provided however, that if the applicant cannot make the certification, the applicant may provide a signed statement with their application detailing the reasons why the certification cannot be made.

All applicants must download the Sexual Harassment Prevention Certification Form from the Pre- submission Upload section, complete and save the form, and upload the completed form back into the Pre-submission Upload folder as part of the application or upload a signed statement detailing the reasons why the certification cannot be made. Important note: Be sure to check the form after uploading to ensure the correct file is uploaded and is completed as required.

Applications that do not contain the certification will not be considered for award; provided however, that if the applicant cannot make the certification, the applicant may provide a signed statement with their application detailing the reasons why the certification cannot be made. After review and consideration of such statement, the Department may reject the application or may decide there are sufficient reasons to accept the application without such certification.

Applicants are required to sign and upload the Sexual Harassment Prevention Certification form or upload a signed statement with their application detailing the reasons why the certification cannot be made.

Executive Order 16

Executive Order No. 16 provides that “all Affected State Entities are directed to refrain from entering into any new contract or renewing any existing contract with an entity conducting business operations in Russia.” The complete text of Executive Order No. 16 can be found at <https://www.governor.ny.gov/executive-order/no-16-prohibiting-state-agencies-and-authorities-contracting-businesses-conducting> . The Executive Order remains in effect while sanctions against Russia imposed by the federal government are in effect. Accordingly, vendors who may be excluded from award because of current business operations in Russia are nevertheless encouraged to respond to solicitations to preserve their contracting opportunities in case the sanctions are lifted during a solicitation or even after award in the case of some solicitations. As defined in Executive Order No. 16, an “entity conducting business operations in Russia” means an institution or company, wherever located, conducting any commercial activity in Russia or transacting business with the Russian Government or with commercial entities headquartered in Russia or with their principal place of business in Russia in the form of contracting, sales, purchasing, investment, or any business partnership. Vendors responding to this solicitation are required to complete and submit the form entitled “Certification Under Executive Order No. 16 Prohibiting State Agencies and Authorities from Contracting with Businesses Conducting Business in Russia”.

All applicants must download the Executive Order 16 Certification Form from the Pre-submission Uploads section of Grants Gateway, complete and save the form, and upload the completed form back into the Pre-submission Uploads folder as part of the application.

Application Evaluation, Scoring, and Selection

Eligibility will be determined according to the factors listed in the table below through review of documents uploaded with the application.

Eligibility Criteria	Score
Vehicle(s) is an eligible vehicle as defined herein and by ECL § 54-1521(1)(c).	Pass/Fail
Vehicle does not have a gross vehicle weight rating of more than 14,000 pounds.	Pass/Fail
The vehicle(s) was purchased or leased and placed into municipal service on or after August 1, 2020, and before the end date of this opportunity.	Pass/Fail
If leased, the term of the lease is no less than 36 months (and the rebate does not exceed to cost of the lease).	Pass/Fail
Vehicle was placed into municipal service at a dealership located in New York State.	Pass/Fail

No further review will take place for applications to the Municipal ZEV Rebate Program. All applications meeting the minimum requirements will be awarded a rebate corresponding to the parameters detailed in the Minimum and Maximum Award Amounts section of this RFA in the order the applications are received in the Grants Gateway.

Awards and Contracting

Awards will be made on a rolling basis, in the order in which the applications are received in the Grants Gateway until allocated funds are exhausted, DEC withdraws this RFA, or September 30, 2022, whichever comes first.

Successful applications for rebates that total \$50,000 or more will not be moved to the contracting process until the grant opportunity has closed and the entire procurement package has been approved by the Office of the State Comptroller and Attorney General, as applicable.

Notification of Award

Applicants selected to receive an award will be notified by mail via an official award letter from the Department.

IMPORTANT NOTE: By accepting an award, applicant agrees to abide by all Master Contract for Grants (MCG) or Letter of Agreement (LOA) terms and conditions. Any changes to the terms and conditions will not be accepted.

State of New York Master Contract for Grants and Letter of Agreement

Applicants selected to receive an award under \$10,000 will be mailed a letter of agreement (LOA) package consisting of the LOA, Attachment A-1 Program Terms and Conditions, signed purchase order, and reimbursement request forms. Applicants should review and be prepared to comply with all LOA and Attachment A-1 Program Terms and Conditions should grant funding be awarded. The LOA and attachments can be reviewed and/or downloaded in the Grants Gateway application under the screen name "Contract Document Properties," or see the Office of Climate Change funding page at <http://www.dec.ny.gov/energy/109181.html#ZEV> for a copy of Attachment A-1 Agency and Program Specific Terms and Conditions ZEV CV.

Applicants selected to receive an award of \$10,000 or more will be sent a "Next Steps" email with instructions for completing the contracting process in the Grants Gateway. Grantees are required to execute a Master Contract for Grants (MCG) within 60 to 90 days from the date of their award letter. Failure to submit required MCG documents in a timely manner could cause a grantee to lose its grant award. Applicants should review and be prepared to comply with all MCG terms and conditions should grant funding be awarded. Contract extensions will not be permitted for the Municipal ZEV Rebate Program.

Reimbursements

Reimbursements (or installment payments) cannot be made until a Master Contract for Grants or Letter of Agreement has been fully executed. After execution, payments up to the eligible reimbursement amount will be made upon approval of the procurement by the Office of the State Comptroller and Attorney General (as applicable) and following the submittal of appropriate reimbursement request information and forms by the grantee.

Project costs eligible for reimbursement must be incurred between the Master Contract for Grants (MCG) or the Purchase Order (PO) term start and end dates. Costs incurred prior to the MCG or PO termstart date or after the MCG or PO term end date will not be considered eligible for reimbursement.

Copies of supporting cost documentation (timesheets, paid invoices, receipts, cancelled checks, etc.) must be audited and approved by the DEC before payment is processed.

Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting

The municipality shall provide the Department with monitoring information, or else allow the Department access to collect information, that documents or estimates the greenhouse gas reductions achieved as a result of the clean vehicle project.

Reserved Rights

The DEC reserves the right to do the following:

- Award additional and available funding for scored and ranked projects consistent with this grant opportunity.
- Award an agreement for any or all parts of this RFA in accordance with the method of award.
- Withdraw this RFA at any time at the Department's sole discretion.
- Award to the next highest scoring application in the event a grantee fails to negotiate a grantcontract with the Department within 60 to 90 days of the grant award.
- Refuse to fund projects that are determined to be inconsistent with the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act or its implementing regulations².
- Reject any or all applications in response to this solicitation at the agency's sole discretion.
- Reduce the rebate amount based on all electric range of the purchased vehicle(s).
- Reclaim funds paid to grantee if false statements regarding eligibility of the project or any if its components are discovered after award or payment has been made.

Debriefing

In accordance with section 163 of the NY State Finance Law, the Department must, upon

request, provide a debriefing to any unsuccessful applicant that responded to the RFA, regarding the reasons that the proposal or bid submitted by the unsuccessful applicant was not selected for an award. An unsuccessful applicant wanting a debriefing must request a debriefing in writing, within 15 calendar days of receipt of the notice that their proposal did not result in an award.
