- (iii) in excess of the daily limit specified for such species; and
- (iv) in a manner contrary to that specified for such species.

- (3) The special regulations set forth in this subdivision shall not apply to:
- (i) Nassau County streams
  - (ii) Suffolk County streams
  - (iii) Croton River from Muscoot Reservoir upstream to confluence with East and West Branches Croton River (Westchester County)
  - (iv) Delaware River downstream of bridge in Lordville (Delaware, Sullivan and Orange counties)
  - (v) Brant Lake Outlet (Warren County)
  - (vi) Rock Pond Outlet Stream (Hamilton County)
  - (vii) Schroon River from Starbuckville Dam upstream to Schroon Lake (Warren County)
  - (viii) Schroon River from Schroon Lake upstream to Alder Meadow Road (Essex County)
  - (ix) Thirteenth Lake Outlet from dam at 13th Lake Road upstream to Thirteenth Lake (Warren County)
