

ADOPT A TRAILHEAD (AAT) APPLICATION

Volunteers are expected to spend time at their assigned trailhead most weekend mornings (including holiday weekends and some Friday afternoons for popular trailheads) from Memorial Day weekend to Columbus Day. Groups are strongly recommended so the time commitment can be divided among the group members, but interested individuals may also apply or contact the AAT Program to get connected with a local volunteer group.

Be sure to mark which activities you'll be doing and note your preferred trailheads (DEC will do their best to meet requests provided the trailheads are not already assigned). Contacts will be provided with training information for group members, forms and instructions for monthly reporting, and any additional program information as needed.
