


Vanderwhacker Mtn Wild Forest - Boreas River Loop Trail

Boreas River Loop Trail extends 1.8 miles along the Boreas River between two trailheads along State Route 28N. The trail weaves through the Boreas Hardwoods region, with many mature, large diameter northern hardwoods. The trail descends 120 feet from in the first 0.6 mile from the trailhead, then climbs 60 feet in the next 0.5 mile and remains basically level for the remainder of the distance to the bridge over the Boreas River. A 0.75-mile hike that ascends, or descends, along the State Route 28N completes the loop.
