ISC/ISAC Coordination & Activity - Josh Thiele and Carrie Brown-Lima

Review of ECL 9-1705: roles of ISC and ISAC

Climate Council (newly formed via E.O. 22) overlaps with ISC (regarding plants).

Steps to take in fulfilling legislative mandates

- Public presence (improved internet identity)
- o Present policy positions (post positions, summaries; newsletter, etc.)
- Internal coordination (agency communications)
- o ISC/ISAC coordination (Inter-organization activity)

ISC/ISAC Coordination

- Relevant questions
 - How can ISAC best communicate recommendations?
 - How can ISC best act on ISAC recommendations and how can ISAC assist?
 - What are the priority issues ISC/ISAC should coordinate on?
- ISAC Survey Priority Topics (14 responses)
 - Outreach (to legislators, staffers, councils, agencies)
 - Regulation of invasive species
 - Pesticide regulation and clarification
 - Climate change
 - Vector management (e.g., canals; clean fill/gravel)
- Perry 1. agencies need a fact sheet to inform commissioners of ISC/ISAC roles.
 - 2. ISC needs to maintain relevancy with current government vis-à-vis climate change, etc.
 - 3. ISC can request time at the next Climate Council to explain.

Dunleavy – ISC needs to be an adjunct to the Climate Council.

Williams – ask the Climate Council what they want from us.

Brown-Lima – ISC/ISAC can offer to look at IS under climate change, given our expertise.

Williams – do we need a formal communications strategy?

Brown-Lima - How can ISAC best contribute to this effort?

Perry – Provide recommendations to the ISC for the communications plan/strategy.

Novak – ISC needs to also focus on internal communications.

Harman – ISAC reps need to reach out to represented groups and be recognized by the plan.

Brincka – should there be an interagency dedicated staff person?

Action Item: ISC will develop a fact sheet for executives that explains the purpose of the ISC and ISAC.

Action Item: ISAC will develop recommendations for communication plan.
