


Blue Ridge Wilderness - Northville-Placid Trail (NPT)

The Northville-Placid Trail (NPT) is a 133-mile trail through the Adirondacks; 11.6 miles of the NPT traverse through the Blue Ridge Wilderness. The NPT has two access points within/near the Blue Ridge Wilderness, the southern terminus is located near Wakely Pond and the northern terminus is located near the DEC Lake Durant Campground; these are also the only official locations within the Blue Ridge Wilderness that the NPT can be accessed through.
