EVENT RECORDS

- 1. Household hazardous waste collection event is registered. 360.15(e) 362-4.2(a)
2. Validated copy of registration is available or posted during the collection event. 360.15(e)
3. Operating activities are performed in accordance with the registration notification. 360.15(e)
4. Notification to the regional office at least 30 days before collection is initiated. 362-4.2(a)(2)
5. A collection event plan is available during the collection event. 362-4.2(a)(3)
6. Collection event plan includes:
a. Procedures to ensure that all collected waste comes from households or CESQGs. 362-4.3(a)(3)(i)
b. Waste determination, handling, and packaging procedures. 362-4.3(a)(3)(ii)
c. Identification of individuals to be present during collection hours to implement procedures. 362-4.3(a)(3)(iii)
d. Qualifications of individuals present during collection hours. 362-4.3(a)(3)(iii)
e. Spill prevention and control plan. 362-4.3(a)(3)(iv)
f. Emergency response plan. 362-4.3(a)(3)(v)
g. Security plan. 362-4.3(a)(3)(vi)
h. Identification of the waste transporter and the facility(ies) that will receive the waste. 362-4.3(a)(3)(vii)
7. Log for each container into which containers of waste or consolidated waste is placed. 362-4.5(a)(1); 362-4.5(a)(2)
8. Log listing each container stored at the facility. 362-4.5(a)(3)
9. Copies of shipping documents or manifests. 362-4.5(a)(4)
10. Annual Report. 362-4.5(b)

WASTE HANDLING

- 11. All waste is removed from the collection site event within 3 days of collection. 362-4.2(a)(4)(i)
12. HHW and CESQG wastes leaving the facility must be transported by a permitted Part 364 transporter 362-4.2(a)(4)(ii)
13. Waste is properly labeled and packaged to prevent, spills, or leaks. 362-4.2(a)(4)(iii)
14. Wastes leaving the facility must be:
a. Accompanied by shipping documents or manifests. 362-4.2(a)(4)(iv)
b. Either reused or managed as hazardous waste at a facility properly permitted or authorized to accept hazardous waste. 362-4.2(a)(4)(v)
