---Please note the following terms and information regarding accessible features in DEC Campground and Day Use Areas---

Accessible Campsites for People with Disabilities (ACPWD) are intended for people with disabilities and provide an accessible picnic table and fireplace/ring, along with firm, stable routes for navigation of a mobility device within the campsite. ACPWD (Natural Surface) have a graded, hard-packed natural surface. ACPWD (Paved Pathways) have paved routes within the campsite.

Accessible Shower Buildings have ADA-compliant bathroom and shower facilities. **Accessible Comfort Stations** have ADA-compliant bathroom facilities.

*[Frontier Town](#) and [Scaroon Manor](#) are two DEC campgrounds built to be fully accessible. In addition to the ACPWD at these facilities maintained for use by wheelchair users, these campgrounds offer a range of campsites suitable for those with limited mobility.

**The [Motorized Access Program for People with Disabilities \(MAPPWD\)](#) is a permit program that provides access for qualified individuals to specified back-country roads and campsites by motor vehicle with a valid permit.
