## REASONS SUPPORTING THIS DETERMINATION:

- 1. The Division of Environmental Protection of the Town of Brookhaven, upon reviewing this action in accordance with SEQR Part 617.3 & 617.6 and comparing it with the thresholds set forth in section 617.4 therein, has determined that this project is a(n) Unlisted Action.
- 2. The Town of Brookhaven Planning Board after review and analysis of the above, the Environmental Assessment Form Parts I and II, the criteria contained in section 617.7, aerial photographs, field reconnaissance, cultural resource, environmental assessment, wetland maps and any other supporting information identifying the relevant areas of environmental concern finds that this action is not anticipated to have a significant effect upon the environment.
- 3. No significant impact is expected to occur to: air, land resources, aesthetic resources, groundwater or surface water resources, archaeological resources, open space and recreation, transportation, energy, and public health nor is the project expected to generate significant noise and odor levels.
- 4. No significant impacts area expected on the growth and character of the community.

5. The proposal will allow for the the storage and sorting of construction and demolition (C&D) debris adjacent to the Long Island Railroad (LIRR) Mainline Branch where a rall spur will provide access to the rail system for disposal at landfills in Ohio. 6. The proposed waste transfer facility will only accept non-putrescible C&D Debris material for transfer. MSW, olls, paints, and pesticides are considered unacceptable waste and will not be permitted entry to the facility for disposal. 7. The transfer station building is intended as mitigation for noise and dust. The building will consist of an impervious surface which will provide the primary mitigation element to protect the groundwater. 8. A NYSDEC Part 360 Permit will be required to accept 1,938 tons per day of C&D material and provide out of state transport of this material by rail.
