Project Description:

New York State Office of General Services (OGS) will dredge the federal navigation channel at Port Ontario, Salmon River, under the REDI Regional Dredging Initiative. Excavators operating on transport scows will dredge an area of 1.4 acres to an elevation of 235.3 feet IGLD85. Three thousand six hundred cubic yards of material will be dredged from an area beginning 400 feet north of the Selkirk Lighthouse Marina, extending approximately 1,000 feet towards Lake Ontario, stopping at the lakeward end of the rock jetty. Scows will deposit the dredged material in a nearshore area in the coastal drift, east of the river's mouth. OGS conducted a Mussel survey, and a license will be issued to relocate the Mussels found within the project area before dredging begins. Turbidity curtains will be required to prevent a contravention of water quality during construction.

Project Description:

The Towns of Sandy Creek and Richland propose to install a new water main extension along North Rainbow Shores Road and South Sandy Pond Inlet Road. The water main will be an extension of the Richland-Sandy Creek Joint Water Project, currently under construction. The proposed extension is approximately 4,500 linear feet and is located within a Coastal Erosion Hazard Area regulated under 6 NYCRR Part 505. The application includes a request for a variance from the restriction at 6 NYCRR Part 505 (d) (5); all development is prohibited on primary dunes unless specifically allowed by this subdivision. The water main is proposed to be directionally drilled under the South Sandy Pond Channel, trenched down the middle of South Sandy Pond Inlet Road, directionally drilled under a dune located at the southern end of South Sandy Pond Inlet Road, and trenched down the middle of North Rainbow Shores Road. Based on the application material reviewed, DEC has made a tentative determination to deny the application. All public comments will be reviewed and considered before a final determination is made.
