Rules and Concepts

** Changes have been made to Co-op operation, please read carefully.

These rules are enforceable by law. You will lose your privileges for any infractions.

- 1. New hunters must register, returning hunters must update their information, and *all* hunters must read, sign, and return this form to coop staff prior to their first hunt of the season.
- 2. All areas are <u>private lands</u> that are "restricted to the public" unless a valid permit is obtained by the DEC prior to hunting. Permits are administered on a daily basis.
- 3. Hunting permits are obtained through reservation (by phone only) on the day prior to your hunt or through "stand-by" (at the window) **after 9:00 AM** on the day of your hunt.
- 4. You and your entire party **must** be pre-registered (for optional hunt) or **CHECK-IN by 9:00 AM** for your reservation or cancel by phone prior to 9:00 AM if you cannot make it.
- 5. All hunting activities must cease by end of legal shooting time (alternate times are specified at check station) and all parties must check out no later than 1 hour after legal shooting time ends.
- 6. <u>Everyone must check out IN PERSON</u> and report any and all game taken. You may be asked to bring your game to the window. If staff is not present at the time of check out, a sign out/harvest report form will be provided. Everyone must sign themselves out. This will be strictly enforced.
- 7. You must park in the immediate area around the red and white parking sign at your designated area. Do NOT park in or block any farm lanes.
- 8. Do NOT cross "boundary" or "restricted" lines. **Trespassing violations** will be reported to the authorities and will result in a loss of privileges.
- 9. It is illegal to discharge a firearm within 500ft, a bow within 150ft, or a crossbow within 250ft of all buildings or occupied structures without the owner's consent.
- 10. Tree stands must be carried in and removed daily.
- 11. **Only deer hunters are allowed a lunch break.** If you must leave your area for any reason, you must check out IN PERSON first.
- 12. Intoxication, foul language, and disruptive behavior will not be tolerated.
