The public is invited to engage with project experts at the Elmira High School Cafeteria between 5:00 and 7:00 PM and get answers to questions or more detailed information. Covid safety requires 3-foot social distancing and masks to be worn at all times while inside.

New York State Department of Environmental Conservation (DEC) and Department of Health (DOH) are overseeing a thorough cleanup of contamination found below-ground on portions of the Elmira High School property. The agencies remain committed to ensuring the students, faculty, and community are kept informed of these actions. DEC will be holding an availability session on **Wednesday, September 29, 2021 at 5 PM** in the cafeteria of the Elmira High School. There will not be a formal presentation. Instead, project experts involved in the cleanups will be available to respond directly to questions and comments from the attending public. Representatives from DEC, DOH, Unisys Corporation, and Elmira High School (EHS) will be available to provide detailed information on the extensive work completed this past year, the ongoing work on the athletic field, and plans for future investigation and cleanup activities. We look forward to addressing your questions and concerns.
