## How was the Property Transferred to ECSD?

Sperry Rand (successor to Remington Rand), now known as Unisys Corporation, conveyed the property to the Chemung County Industrial Development Agency on 28 December 1973. On 21 April 1977, Chemung County Industrial Development Agency conveyed the property to Westinghouse and that same day Westinghouse conveyed that property to ECSD.
