MOTION: Dave Corr to accept December minutes; Ray Osypian, Second, Motion passed.

Executive Report:

Judy Drabicki, Executive Deputy Commissioner; Jane McLaughlin, Director, Legislative Affairs; Maureen Wren, Director, Office of Media Relations

- Jane provided an update on Legislative Bills from the last two years. The Executive Budget summary will be provided at the February meeting. The budget presentation is expected to occur on January 21st.
- Judy provided an update on the State of the State details. Some of those details include: Triple walleye production from the hatchery system, increase in Trout and Salmon production, Improving Fishing Access Sites, etc.

- The tentative completion date for the new license system is June 1st. If the deadline cannot be met then it will be pushed to January 1, 2021.

- The Division will be hiring for a new position, Access to Private Lands Specialist. Interviews are to be held at the end of January.
- The Region 5 Fishery Manager position has been filled.

- The Board discussed the pheasant stocking program and distribution of day-old chicks. The Division provides information on pheasant stocking on the DEC website.

- Jim provided an update on the Cortland Water Department captive deer herd. He discussed the licensing of the facility, the compliance issues, public feeding, etc.
