The following are needed for the successful processing of your application:

- Completely fill out all the requested information on the application.
 - If you are using a post office box to receive mail, please include a legal address (street address) with your application or it will be returned.
- The application Affirmation must be signed and dated.
- **Permit Fee:** ALL applications submitted by mail must be paid by check or money order payable to NYSDEC. Starter checks are not accepted. Cash and Visa/Mastercard are accepted for in-person applicants.
 - \circ There will be a \$20.00 fee for all returned checks.
 - Applicants from outside the United States must contact the Marine Permit Office to determine acceptable forms of payment for application fees.
- **Photograph:** Submit with your application a recent, clear passport size photograph of yourself, approximately 1 ½ x 2 inches. A photograph is not required if you are renewing from the preceding year.
- Applicants **under 16 years of age** must the application signed and notarized by a parent or legal guardian.

BUSINESS OR CORPORATE APPLICATION CHECK LIST

This information is provided for all applicants that are applying as a domestic corporation, domestic limited liability company (LLC), foreign business corporation, foreign LLC, or under an assumed name (DBA). Please review your application and make sure all required information is included and the application is signed before returning your application to DEC. Incomplete or incorrect information will delay the processing of your application.

Note: If you hold a Corporate Food Fish License (Resident or Non-Resident), you must renew your license each year to maintain eligibility in the fishery.

Required Supplemental Documents

- The Marine Permit Office requires applicants renewing a license or permit in the name of a corporation or LLC to provide documentation with their renewal applications showing that their business status is ACTIVE. Detailed instructions on complying with this requirement are given below.
- Your permits will not be renewed without this information.
- All Food Fish Resident, Food Fish Non-Resident, Food Fish Landing, Party and Charter Boat, and shellfish
 vessel endorsement applicants must include a photocopy of a valid state vessel registration or USCG
 Certificate of Documentation.

Corporation and Business Status (Active) Search Instructions

You will be directed to a page with your business's information. Please check to ensure you found the correct business and that the information is correct.
- 8. **Please print this page.** Include the printed page with your renewal application. Please remember this document must be dated no earlier than 30 days before you submit your renewal application to the DEC Marine Permit Office.

NOTE: If your business name does not appear, please ensure you typed the entries correctly. You may have to modify the wording in the '**Entity Name**' box to get a correct search result. For example, if your company name is LONG ISLAND BLUEFISH, you may search for LONG ISLAND, LONG ISLAND BLUE, ISLAND BLUE or BLUEFISH using the '**Search Types**' "Partial" or "Contains."

If you are operating as a DBA, please provide a copy of your business certificate that is provided by the county where you operate your business or under an assumed name (DBA).
